2) ISWG Updates	<p>Over 106,000 refugees currently in the country.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 109,413 people have received TP including 1,115 TCN. No massive changes to the demographics. (Still mostly females and children) <p>2023 RRP latest Dates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The regional 2023 RRP received. • The Romania chapter is under translation to Romanian. • The official launch of 2023 RRP will take place in Geneva on 15 February 2023. • The country launch is planned to take place between 15 to 20 February 2023. UNHCR is in consultation with the Government to set the date and modality of the launch which will be shared. <p>ActivityInfo platform for 2023 has changed based on feedbacks and best practices in other places. IM section of the IA are currently training RRP partners and other organizations on the new platform. It is important that all concerned organizations</p>	

	<p>attend the training. New sectors have been added to the platform based on the revised Inter-Agency Coordination Structure. (an email was sent out last week)</p> <p>· The Service advisor platform which is now being used in Ukraine and Moldova will be available here by 1 April 2023. Refugees would use this platform to know about the location of available services.</p> <p>The platform is multilingual: Ukrainian, Russian, Romanian, Arabic and English.</p> <p>The ISWG is planning to have a specific session on the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) in March. (An email was disseminated last week with a link to the survey) The session will be in English and Romanian. The final date and time will be shared soon.</p> <p>UNICEF- A shipment of 15,000 sets of children's winter clothes is going to arrive in Bucharest on 11 February. If any partner needs children winter clothes, please contact UNICEF.</p> <p>A statement was made during the meeting that with the upcoming vacation season approaching soon in Constanta, it is expected that upwards of 20,000 Ukrainian refugees will be uprooted from their places of lodging in hotels/rentals, etc....</p>
