2) Updates from the IA	<p><b>IMWG meeting- 24 March 2023</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- As of 3/20, 110,000 UA's in Romania; 3% increase since 1 January (Monthly average -109,500 in RO)</li> </ul>	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 124,000 TP permits issued- 60% female, 40% male</li> <li>- TCN's- 1200 TP permits issued</li> <li>- In 2022, 12,556 Asylum applications: UA's- 4403, India- 1488. Top ten countries account for 89% of asylum applications</li> <li>- Services Advisor- mapping site/program, modelled on the service provider mapping site in Moldova:</li> <li>- Anticipate it will go live between 1-7 April in RO</li> <li>- UNHCR wants to map anti-human trafficking providers:</li> <li>- Site will be open to all providers, but they want to map partner agencies and known NGO's first!</li> <li>- UNHCR's Facundo Palermo is the POC; he asks that we reach out to him/his colleagues to figure out how to do the mapping quickly...they don't have the resources to enter all the data; it takes about 30 minutes to "map" a complex site on the back-end of the system</li> </ul>

<p>4) Updates on activities/identified trends/areas of concern</p>	<p><b>Monthly Narratives in the Sharepoint - <a href="#">Monthly Narratives in the Sharepoint</a></b>  Reminder for the Activity Info App and Monthly Reports</p> <p><b>The 50/20 program for the refugees - In process of being adopted, but some aspects are still not certain.</b></p> <p>Essence of the ordinance:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 2000 lei/per family/4 months - on condition that UA are employed or allowance for unemployment</li> <li>- Children - theoretically they are being given an allowance, but in practice there is no methodology for receiving it.</li> <li>- language barrier in order to be employed easier - the state do not provide English classes, only NGOs</li> <li>- they sent their proposals in the Livelihoods, there was a person from the gov present there</li> </ul> <p>Issues not clear/sure yet:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- State Councillor Turza said 50/20 program might be continued for vulnerable people - other state auth said it is not true.</li> <li>- no concrete information about this program - disinformation</li> </ul>	<p>Please share a short paragraph describing your main achievements and activities for the month of March 2023 - here: <a href="#">APRIL 2023 TIP Monthly Narrative IA Template (1).docx</a></p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 20 unaccompanied children + guardia - count as one family or as 20 families?</li> </ul> <p>Issues to be addressed with the government:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- the short term of implementation of these measures - UA havent been informed that soon the 50/20 program will be changed.</li> <li>- some owners have given a 3 day notice of leaving the apartments - landlords do not want to offer rent to UA because of this new change of the 50/20 program.</li> <li>- insist that the gov delay the implementation of this ordinance and properly inform the UA.</li> <li>- unaccompanied minors - there is still need for clarity, because it was told that they could still be considered for 50/20 - but they cannot have bank accounts - and for this allowances, bank accounts are necessary.</li> <li>- the ordinance does not allow the civil society to send proposals for amendments</li> </ul> <p><b>The GBV Referral pathway:</b></p> <p>The document was discussed with Konstantina Loupeidou and the information and contacts of the organisations were confirmed. The referral pathway soon to be shared among member when finalised.</p>	
AOB	<b>Employment contracts for Ukranians</b> - still no official translation services offered to the UA.	Share direct contacts from institutions responsible for employment contracts for UA.
