



Age and Gender Breakdown*




Sub-prefectures hosting asylum seekers



1. UNHCR considers that people fleeing Burkina Faso or Mali need international protection in accordance with Article 1, paragraph 2, the OAU Convention in 1969. and the criteria of the 1951 Convention to obtain refugee status.

2. These people are being registered pending their refugee status in Côte d'Ivoire.



The main reasons for the departure of asylum seekers from their villages in Burkina Faso are armed conflicts / Generalized insecurity, threats, intimidation and attacks by unidentified armed groups in the villages.
