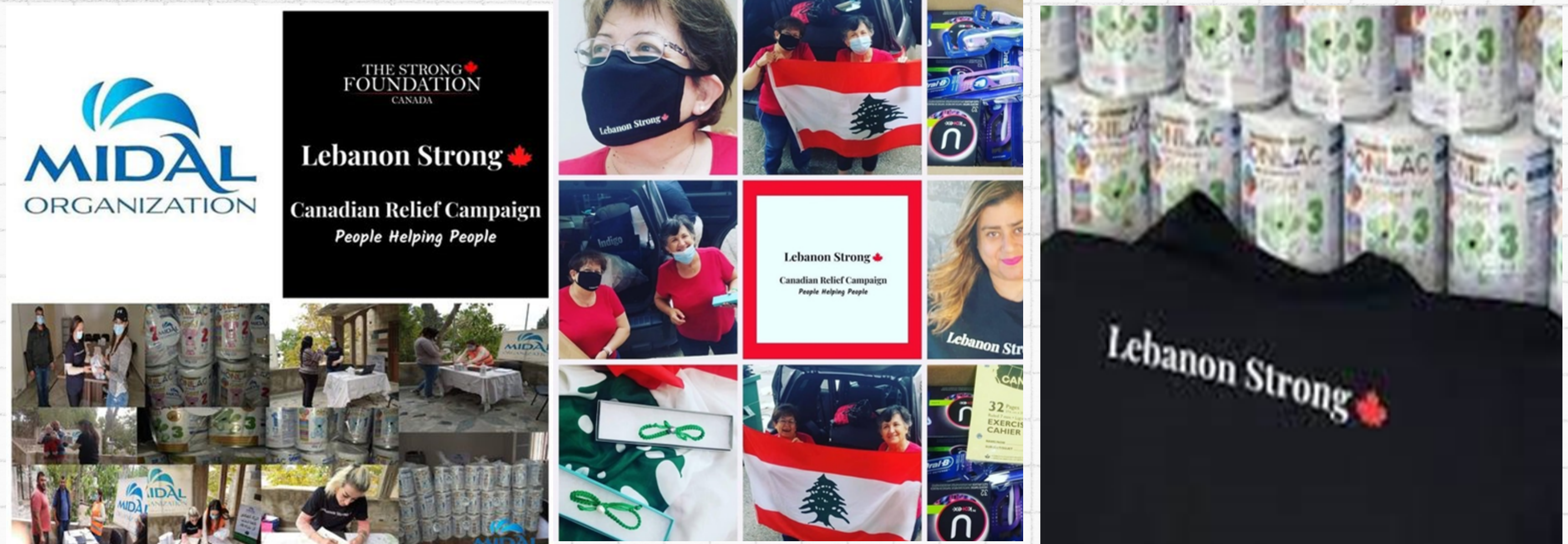

Developmental programs

EDUCATIONAL PROJECT

- This project aims to support youth and young women through support in educational sponsorship, vocational trainings.
- Every year more than 90 classes are open to support women and youth.
- In 2022, 620 youth and women benefitted from this program
1120 youth and young women are participated in the mentoring program.
- Scholarship for girls and Alumna's in collaboration with Girls for Life foundation Europe.

Economic empowerment

These programs aim to enhance community capacity to address the issues of poverty. It may be in the form of making plans or giving skills training , job employment, to help the people become more productive members of society. Other program leaders may also partner with both local and private sectors to reach more audience and gather sponsors.

All in all, these initiatives give people a chance to share efforts to build their households, making them active agents of change.

- Women economic empowerment in the mediterranean areas: is a regional project leaded by MIDAL in partnership with terzo millennio. It's a regional study about the situation of young women and economic support through STEAM: 2022/2025
- START AND GROW: a livelihood project in southern Lebanon: Agri-Pro, Oil Soap Factory, organizing " Events " Zaffat group" by young girl and women, Handcrafts and sewing project leaded by women, fashion and accessories handmade project. This project is funded by Civitas Solis and EU2022/2024.

- Psycho-social support for women and girls.
- Case management and referral: 730 individuals participated to awareness sessions and 105 are men. They are also received hygiene kits /2022.
