Coordination updates (Updates from the field)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Azraq camp:<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ The Protection Unit conducted the Joint PWG & CP-SGBV SWG – Azraq meeting on 21st June 2023, which is chaired by UNHCR and co-chaired by DRC & IRC with the following agenda:<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Cyber Sexual Harassment Presentation – IRC.b. Amaali Application Update. A Suggestion WAS to separate camps services from urbans.c. World Refugee Day celebration on 20th June.d. Working Agencies updates.▪ One UNHCR staff from Azraq camp and another one from TdH “EJC” attended the “GBV Safe referral ToT training”.▪ A new GBV project in EJC camp implemented by UNHCR & IFH starts in June 2023, where one GBV caseworker will cover GBV cases in EJC.▪ The EJC Monthly Camp Coordination Meeting was held on 19th June 2023 at TdH site, the meeting covered the following topics:<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ World Refugee Day 20 June.

- UNHCR conducted “**CP safe referral**” training targeting IBVs in EJC camp on 25th June 2023, total participants were 23 (10 females, 13 males).
- Received new instructions related to the child marriage process by Azraq Sharia court. The instructions will be implemented accordingly.

- **Zaatari:**

- IFH cochaired with UNHCR and IMC the CP-GBVSWG monthly meeting.
- # of child early marriage cases in 2022 was 287, while Up till 2023 # of child early marriage cases increased to 321 cases. Will start working on strategy in camp with all working agencies and a plan to decrease the CP marriage cases (prevention & response) and to be fit on the national level by NCFA.
- Also, to receive monthly updates from all agencies on services for the effect on CP marriage cases. And to conduct a bi-yearly assessment for this strategy and plan.
- World Refugee Day celebration in the camp was cancelled, due to the tragic accidents affected refugees, which occurred during June (the boat sinking in the Mediterranean Sea and car accident in Mafraq).
- Amaali app – all agencies are required to update their data (responses shown). Nisreen from UNHCR will be the FP and will attend the upcoming meeting to check for any inquiry.
- IFH staff attended the GBV Safe Referral ToT training.

- **Mafraq:**

- the CP GBVWG meeting will be conducted the same day of the “Referrals Coordination Meeting” – RCM (Back-to-back). Meeting is scheduled every lastThursday of each month.
- A Child Marriage Network was created with working partners and authorities, the network won’t have a chair nor Co-Chair for this network as the leading will be on rotational basis.

- **Irbid:**

- CP-GBV SWG meeting was held, the members shared the update on their projects and activities.

The recommendations were discussed and validated with GBV SWG members ; received comments were incorporated accordingly. 	
<p>DMDT Presentation on Vocational Training and kits for GBV survivors</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - DMDT is a local organization established in 2016, their aim is to Empower and develop the skills and capabilities of individuals, communities & organizations in Jordan and the region. - Their current project (No women left behind) is launched by AIDOS and implemented by DMDT, AWO and VdT. - The project goal is to Improve the quality of life for women with disabilities and/or at risk and/or survivors of gender-based violence among refugees and host communities in Mafraq and Amman governorates. - Current project is aiming to provide beneficiaries with a 5 day training on soft skills and 20 days of vocational training, the trainings will include beauty, tailoring, ICT and handicrafts. - It was agreed with DMDT to receive further details on the project to be presented to the GBV SWG members, to enable them to better refer beneficiaries to this program. 	<p>https://docs.google.com/presentation/d/1izccHTYJ9zyqP_7YN6Md5dyb5zNENdyb/edit?usp=drive_link&oid=115712813998041622874&rtpof=true&sd=true</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- IRC is working on a press release on Child marriage at the national level in Jordan. It will be launched mid-July – Beginning of August as they are waiting Mol approval. The article will provide information on child marriage cases analysing the figures amongst different locations.- IRC will start the E-map training on 16th July to train the partners only at time being.- Interagency coordination will share GBV indicators as part of Activity INFO once finalized.- Frequency of Entering data for all working agencies (monthly or quarterly basis) will be determined and communicated by the Interagency coordination unit.
