- **Arcenciel:**
No updates.
- **AVSI:**
Partnering with Arcenciel in Bakalian site in CfW activities in the rubble to mountain project by cleaning glass.
Arcenciel is providing technical expertise and will be in charge of crushing the glass.
- **Irshad and Islah:**
No SoST activities in BML.
- **IRC:**
Ongoing protection monitoring activities.
- **INTERSOS:**
Under the CSP program, they have an increase in the budget and started the implementation of Solar Street Light in Ketermaya and Aley. And will start the implementation of the same project in Sinn el Fil. They also have three projects of solarization of water wells in partnership with the water establishments in Yahshoush, Nahr Ibrahim, and Choueifat.
- **LNE:**
No current SoST programs but exploring potential collaborations with municipalities.
- **Sahaja:**
Can offer peacebuilding activities.
- **Oxfam:**
Currently no SoST activities in BML.
- **International Alert:**
Working in upper Chouf with CSOs to increase their capacities. Currently, they are in the process of outreaching a consultant to build their capacities which will be followed by providing them with a small grant to implement a small initiative.
- **Makhzoumi:**
Yalla Nefroz project is ongoing.
Bins distribution in greater Beirut.
- **UNOPS:**
Under the Sima project, they are conducting a second phase of the assessment and the results should come up in a couple of months.
Preparing for workshops.
A lot of progress in terms of preparation and the project will be launched soon.

- **Two Referrals:**

1- As requested by the North Iqlim el Kharroub Union of municipalities, the community support project includes the installation of Solar Streetlights in strategic roads in the municipalities that fall under the aforementioned Union of municipalities. The distribution of the solar streetlights is as follows: Jadra (126), Mghayrieh (110), Aanout (180), Barja (1000), Daraya (280), Alman (150), Dalhoun (320), Rmeile (184), Jiye (200), Werdeniye (160), Baaseer (300), Burjeyn (150), Chhim (300), Daher Meghara (65).

2- "As requested by the Ministry of social affair, the community support project consists of replacing the batteries and relevant controllers for the existing streetlights on the road connecting costal Chouf with the upper chouf till Deir el Amar (The concerned municipalities are Damour, Mechref, Dmit, Kfar Him, and Deir El-Qamar). It is important to highlight that the existing solar streetlight system consists of a led lamp, solar panel, a battery, and a controller each. A total of 150 batteries and 150 controllers are required to ensure an appropriate function of the solar streetlight system in the aforementioned road. "
