In the week of the World Refugee Day, the Interiorization, Integration and Humanitarian Transportation sector of the Inter-Agency Coordination Platform for Refugees and Migrants from Venezuela (R4V) in Brazil launched a report gathering successful stories among the more than 100,000 people relocated in the country.

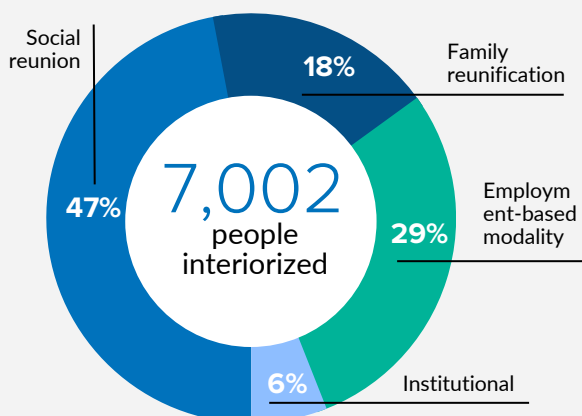
By highlighting their dreams, opportunities and desires, the document emphasizes the Interiorization strategy as a tool that enables people to achieve autonomy.

The material was organized by UNHCR, IOM and World Vision, in partnership with the Ministry of Social Development and Fight Against Hunger, with a presentation by minister Wellington Dias. It also had the contribution of several organizations that work in the engagement of the private sector, mobilization of the local network, delivery of financial assistance, sheltering, among other actions within the scope of Interiorization.

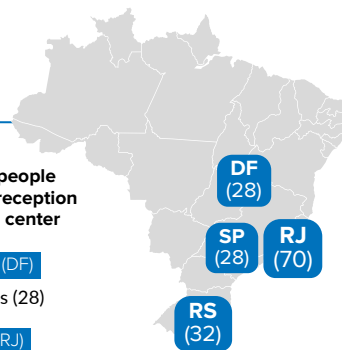

Celebrating World Refugee Day

On 20 June, World Refugee Day, we celebrate the resilience and diversity and acknowledge the challenges refugee people face, but we also value the cultural, professional and human contributions they bring to the host country.

Under the motto #HopeAwayFromHome, UNHCR carried out an activity with the community welcomed in Aldeias Infantis in Brasilia to express what they understand by home, hope and integration in Brazil. Local integration was the theme launched by UNHCR in view of the current setting of 110 million forcibly displaced people in the world. The Interiorization strategy has become an example in providing opportunities for Venezuelan people to rebuild their lives with dignity in Brazil.



Advocacy

UNHCR accompanied representatives of the Municipal Secretary of Citizenship and Human Rights of Esteio (RS) on a visit to Boa Vista, in order to sensitize managers and strengthen the work developed with *Operação Acolhida*. A pioneer in welcoming Venezuelan people, the municipality has a reference service and a shelter for migrants and refugees. Since 2018, **685** people have been transferred to Esteio.

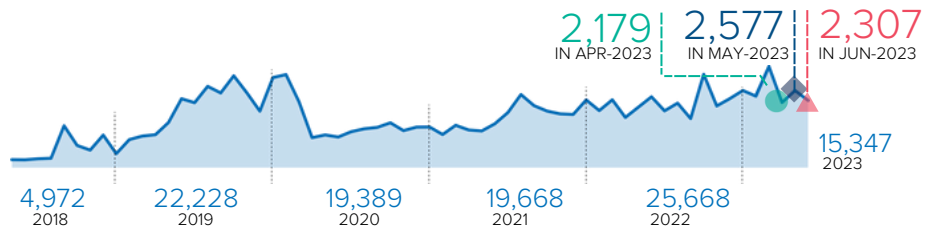
625 people sheltered in the BV-8 Transit Shelter in Pacaraima in the Interiorization flow

Overview of the Interiorization Strategy from April 2018 to June 2023

The Federal Government's Interiorization strategy, implemented by Operação Acolhida, voluntarily relocates Venezuelan refugees and migrants from the states of Roraima to other cities in the country.
