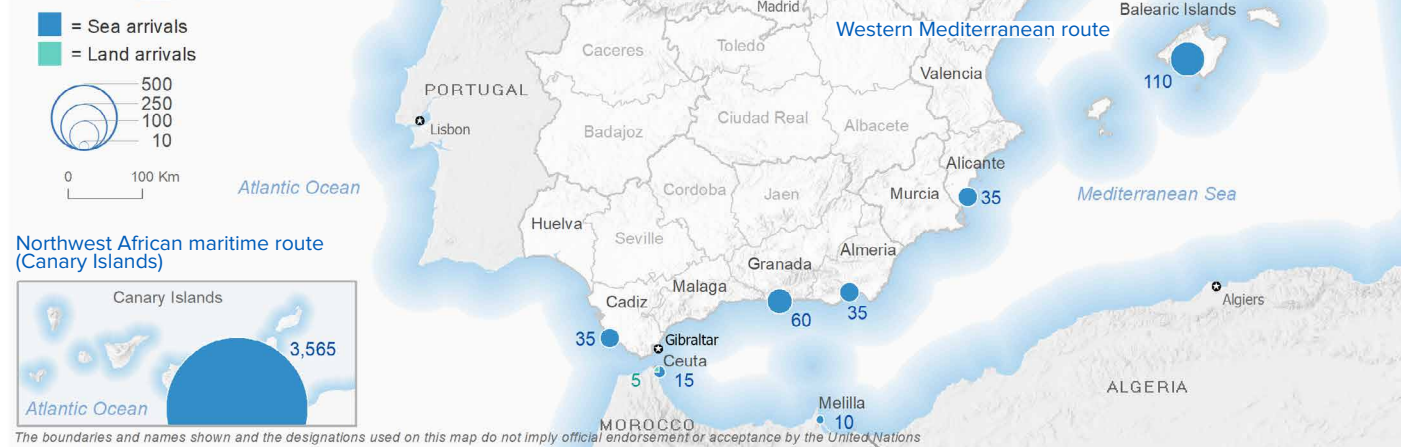


# SPAIN Weekly snapshot - Week 40 (2 - 8 Oct 2023)

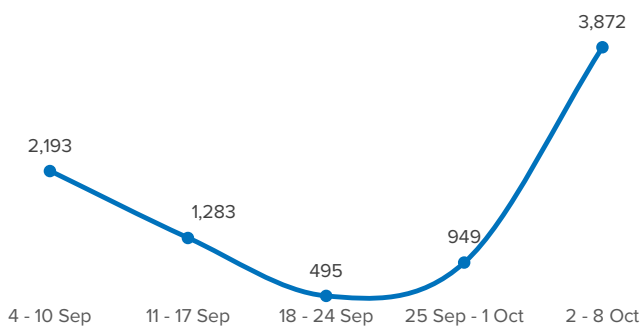

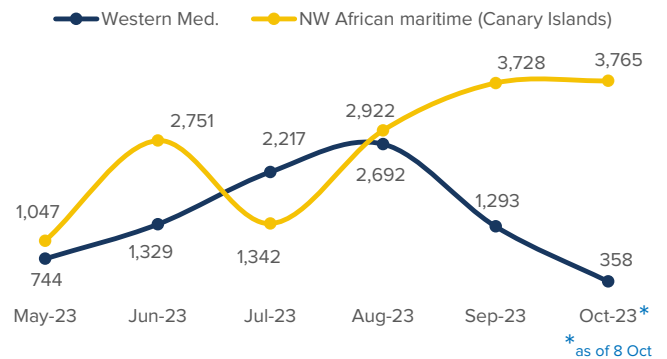

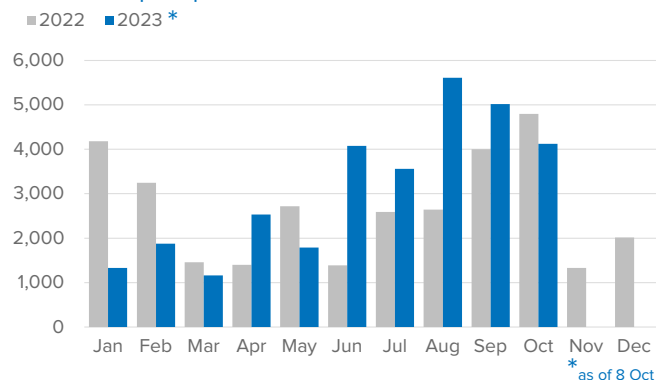
## Arrivals in Spain during the last five weeks<sup>1</sup>
