

# Overview of Refugees and Asylum-seekers in Uganda

as of 31-Mar-2024



Since the start of 2024, more than 44,700 individuals (including more than 7,400 new births) have been registered in Uganda, 30% of whom are new arrivals from Sudan, 18% from South Sudan, 16% from Eritrea, and 13% from the DR Congo. There was an increase of 15,232 individuals (0.9%) in the population from last month, resulting mainly from new arrival and continuous registration activities. Notably, the number of registered Sudanese increased since the start of the Sudan conflict in April 2023, averaging more than 3,900 individuals per month over the last three months.






