I. Review Action Points & Announcements

- Many thanks to the partners who took the time to provide data, CVA Mapping activity for 2023 is nearly completed. Results and relevant dashboard will be shared with partners soon.
- CBI TWG Technical Advisory Group (TAG) will be restructured soon due to departure of some colleagues. A detailed announcement will be made for colleagues who want to be a part of the TAG.

II. Operational Planning

Partner CVA Updates

- Partners shared updates regarding their ongoing and planned CVA programmes.
 - SGDD-ASAM: ASAM completed their MPCA project targeting EQ survivors within the scope of winterisation as of April 20th. TRY 8265 cash support provided to 2261 beneficiaries in Hatay, Kahramanmaraş, Ankara and Malatya. ASAM is willing to share their recently completed PDM and FGDs results in the next meeting.
 - SARD: SARD completed their MPCA project in Adiyaman rural areas. Overall, 668 HHs ((2543 individuals). Their next cash project will also target rural areas of Adiyaman particularly center and Gölbaşı. SARD is currently conducting PDMs and willing to share the results once they are completed.
 - WFP: WFP provided information on their upcoming two cash programmes. First project will target Hilalkent camp and approximately TRY 700 will be disseminated to non-SSN beneficiaries residing in Hilalkent camp. For this project, WFP continues advocacy with donor organization to provide this amount as MPCA. Second project will target voluntarily transitioning families from camps to rural areas. Details will be shared by a presentation in the coming meetings.
 - UDER: UDER targeted 322 families in Nurdağı and Islahiye camps with CVA and distributed their transfer amount based on the CBI TWG guidance. Transfers are completed by the end of March and first week of April. Currently, PDMs are being conducted.
 - CARE: CARE completed their shelter rehabilitation projects recently in Adana, Gaziantep and Şanlıurfa targeting approximately 500 houses.
 - UNFPA: UNFPA is looking for building referral pathways with NGOs in the field for their programme in which they provide unconditional and unrestricted cash assistance to GBV survivors in the EQ zone within case management.
 - IBC: IBC completed their GIZ-funded MPCA project in Hatay, Gaziantep, Adiyaman, Kilis, Konya, Kayseri and Aksaray. They are in the planning step for a cash programme with World Vision.

Post-Distribution Monitoring of CVA

- Inter-agency Summary Guidance Note on Post-Distribution Monitoring (PDM) in Cash-Based Interventions (CBIs) is developed by the CBI TWG shares valuable insights from previous discussions and field experiences. This document helps practitioners understand how to use PDM tools effectively in CBIs. It's full of practical advice and lessons learned, gathered from past conversations. And because it's a living document, we're constantly updating it with new suggestions and findings from partners. This guidance note isn't just about know now, but also about next directions in improving CBI programmes.
- **ORANGE** presented PDM report for their "Earthquake Emergency Response – Cash-Based Intervention through Value Vouchers" programme. The programme covered over 40.000 beneficiaries residing in Hatay and Kahramanmaraş camps and the PDM was conducted in October. Overall, 341 beneficiaries were interviewed via phone calls, online surveys and door-to-door visits.
- The value voucher mostly used for food and NFIs (40% female, 23% male) and satisfaction with the variety of materials were high (48% female, 30% male).
- Regarding feedback mechanisms, 33% of the beneficiaries indicated that they did not know about feedback mechanisms in place and over 67% of the beneficiaries preferred direct phone calls as the feedback tool. For more details, please see relevant slides.
- **IOM** presented their PDM dashboard for an MPCA programme conducted in the EQ affected provinces. The data was collected in February 2024 and the report is prepared in March. Overall, 186 interviews were conducted and male – female ratio of the respondents is 58% - 42%, respectively.
- Of the respondents, 37% receives SSN while 63% is non-SSN beneficiaries and 37% indicated presence of disability for one or more HH members. Even though most of the beneficiaries utilized the amount for buying food (82%), there are various spending areas from shelter repair to electricity. Details can be found in IOM's PDM dashboard shared with minutes.
- A PDM report can be created collaboratively by CBI TWG including partners' PDM reports after they complete their programmes to determine beneficiary preferences and provide other information that can be useful for future programmes in Türkiye.

Updates on CVA Mapping 2023

- CBI Mapping for 2023 is almost completed and 17 organizations reported information regarding their 52 programmes. The budget is calculated as USD 1.9 million and almost 5 million beneficiaries were reached by partners in 2023. 24 of the programmes were designed to respond to the EQ while 12 is repurposed to respond to the needs after EQ and 16 were not EQ response intervention. 26 of the reported programmes were MPCA while 33 were emergency cash assistance programme.
- Details regarding CVA Mapping 2023 will be presented shortly and relevant dashboard will be shared once data cleaning is completed.

Skills Gap Analysis

- CBI TWG Capacity Building Plan prepared in collaboration with CALP was presented.
- CBI TWG will engage in ongoing discussions with CALP to solidify the capacity building plan. Partners will be contacted for their invaluable technical, logistical, and financial support, thus ensuring the utmost effectiveness of the Capacity Building Plan. The planned learning events are subject to availability of resources. While preparing the capacity building plan, the skill gaps and members' priorities were considered.
- Trainings are divided into five different steps of learning and core trainings and market assessment tools trainings are prioritized due to needs highlighted in the skills gap analysis survey. For details please kindly see relevant slides.
