

ITALY Sea arrivals dashboard

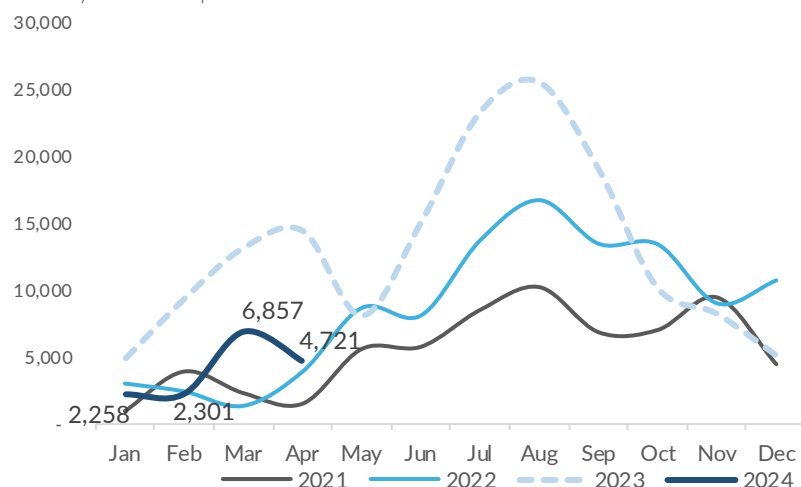
Overview

In the first four months of 2024, 16,137 refugees and migrants arrived in Italy by sea, compared to 42,201 in the same period last year (-62%). Most of the 4,721 people arrived in April disembarked in Sicily (4,315), followed by Emilia-Romagna (202), Calabria (136), Tuscany (55) and Sardinia (13).

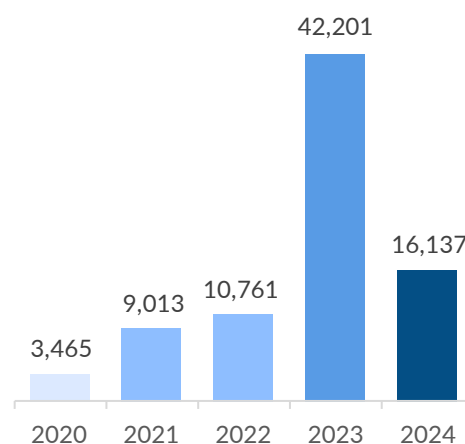
Monthly sea arrivals

Yearly sea arrivals

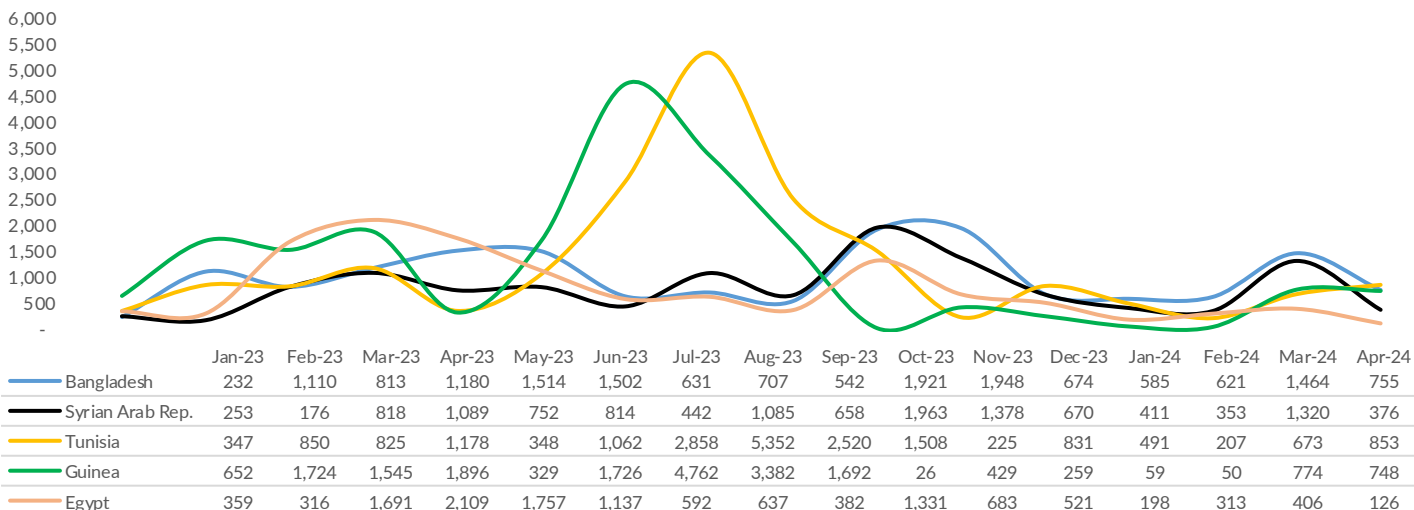
January to April, 2020-2024



Nationality of arrivals

In April, 18 per cent of arrivals were Tunisian (10% in March), followed by 16 per cent Bangladeshi (21% in March) and Guinean (11% in March). Among other nationalities of people arriving in significant numbers by sea were Syrian (8%), Ivorian (6%), Cameroonian and Malian (5% each), Senegalese and Sudanese (4% each), and Gambian (3%). In April, as in March, the main nationalities of people departing from Libya were Bangladeshi (55%, 34% in March), Syrian (25%, 31% in March), and Egyptian (9%, as in March). Most of those departing from Tunisia were Tunisian (25%, 26% in March), Guinean (22%, 26% in March) and Ivorian (8%, 6% in March).

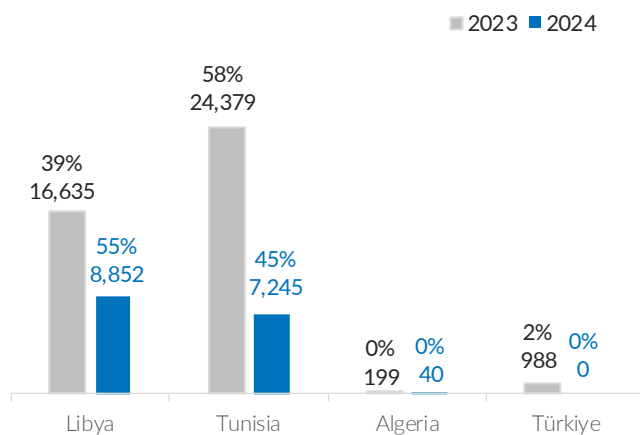
Most common nationalities of people arriving by sea - January 2023 to April 2024



Country of embarkation

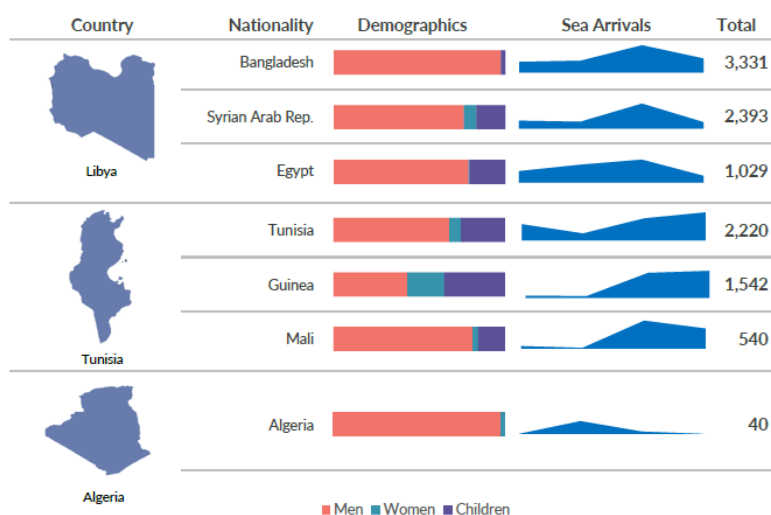
Overall, in the first four months of 2024, 55 per cent of the people reaching Italy via sea departed from Libya (8,852 people in 160 landings), followed by 45 per cent from Tunisia (7,245 people in 230 landings), and less than 1 per cent from Algeria (40 people in 6 landings). In April, unlike in March, Tunisia was the main country of departure (corresponding to 72% of people landing in Italy), followed by Libya (28%).

January to April 2023 - 2024



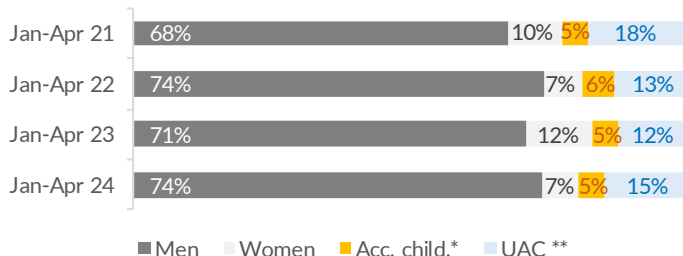

In the first four months of 2024, most people arriving by sea were adult males (74%), followed by unaccompanied children (UAC, 15%), adult females (7%) and accompanied children (5%).

In April, 451 adult females reached Italian shores, mainly originating from Guinea (180), Côte d'Ivoire (71), Tunisia (63) and the Syrian Arab Republic. (33).

In the same month, 803 UAC arrived in Italy by sea. The main nationalities were Guinean (217), Tunisian (185), Ivorian (81) and Gambian (79).
