1. 2023 GBV Safety Audit Vanessa Bordin, GBV SWG Co-lead	<p>The 2023 GBV safety audit is an exercise that helped identifying what are the risks of GBV that are present in a context using different methodologies for the data collection. The audit provides a guidance with tools that can be applicable in different contexts and can be localized to reflect what are the needs and what are the risks that are present in a specific context.</p> <p>The 2023 GBV safety audit is a bit more comprehensive than the 2022 one, as it included 39 focus group discussions that were done in line with the age, gender, and diversity approach, meaning that there were included different groups, and persons with different backgrounds.</p> <p>The 2023 GBV Safety Audit can be found here.</p>	PSEA Focal Points to familiarize themselves with the 2023 GBV Safety Audit and to use it in practice.
2. Investigator Qualification Training Scheme Catalina Birsanu, Inter-Agency Coordination Associate	<p>The Investigator Qualification Training Scheme (IQTS) is comprised under the Outcome 4, Output 4.1. (investigation) of the PSEAH Action Plan for 2024.</p> <p>The purpose of IQTS is strengthening the local capacity to respond to sexual abuse, exploitation and harassment (SEAH) in the Republic of Moldova.</p> <p>The goal is to equip new investigators with the critical skills and knowledge to undertake survivor-centered investigations by using a standardized, high-quality approach to investigating allegations of SEAH.</p> <p>The IQTS Tier 1 is available online and it is free for everyone. Tier 2 started on June 10th and will continue until July 8th. Tier 3 will follow from autumn onwards.</p> <p>Currently there are enrolled 37 participants from UN Agencies, INGOs and local CSOs.
