

# ITALY Sea arrivals dashboard

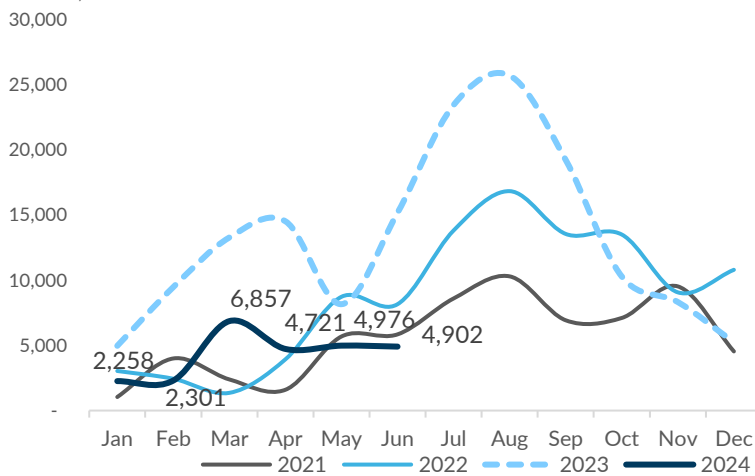
## Overview

In the first half of 2024, 26,015 refugees and migrants arrived in Italy by sea, compared to 65,519 in the same period last year, a decrease of 60 per cent. Most of the 4,902 people who arrived in June disembarked in Sicily (3,594), followed by Calabria (490), Liguria (216), Campania and Sardinia (132 each), Abruzzo (106), Tuscany (111), Marche (67), and Lazio (54).

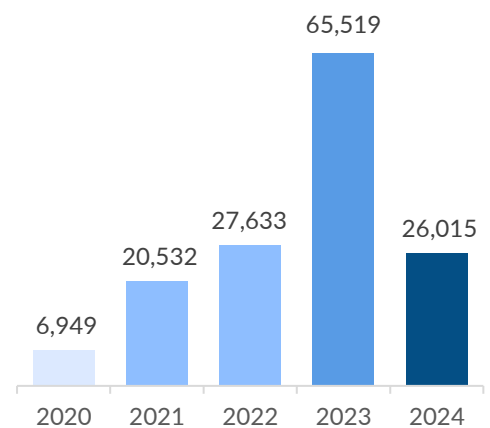
### Monthly sea arrivals

### Yearly sea arrivals

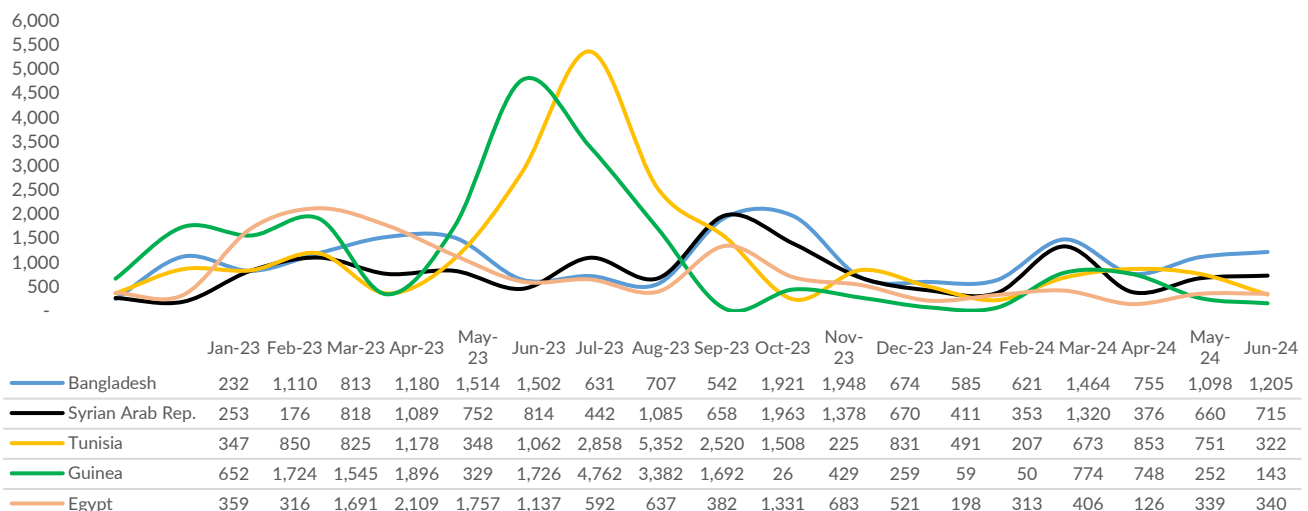
January to June, 2020-2024



## Nationality of arrivals

In June, Bangladeshis accounted for a quarter of all arrivals by sea (22% in May), followed by 15 per cent Syrians (13% in May) and 7 per cent from Egypt and Tunisia each (7% of Egyptians and 15% of Tunisians in May). Among other nationalities arriving in significant numbers by sea were Sudanese (6%), Gambians, Pakistanis, Eritreans, and Iranians (4% each), Afghans, Ethiopians, Guineans, and Algerians (3% each). In June, as in May, the main nationalities of those departing from Libya were Bangladeshi (38%, 41% in May), Syrian (22%, 25% in May), and Egyptian (9%, 12% in May). Most of those departing from Tunisia were Tunisian (30%, 39% in May), Sudanese (17%, 4% in May), and Guinean (12%, the same as in May). The majority departing from Türkiye were Iranians (33%, 28% in May), Afghans (27%, 23% in May), and Pakistanis (18%, 21% in May). Most departing from Algeria were Algerians (96%, 100% in May).

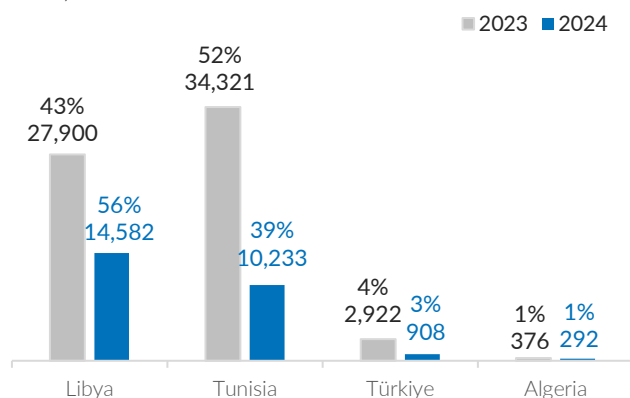
Most common nationalities of people arriving by sea - January 2023 to June 2024



## Country of embarkation

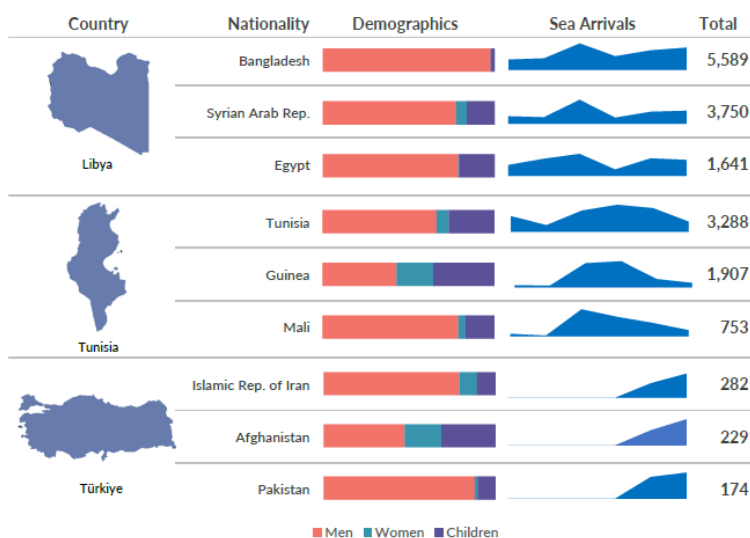
In the first half of 2024, 56 per cent of the people reaching Italy via sea departed from Libya (14,582 people in 289 landings), followed by 39 per cent from Tunisia (10,233 people in 340 landings), 3 per cent from Türkiye (908 people in 14 landings), and 1 per cent from Algeria (292 people in 29 landings). In June, as in May, Libya was the main country of departure (accounting for 64% of people landing in Italy), followed by Tunisia (22%), Türkiye (11%) and Algeria (3%).

January to June 2023 - 2024



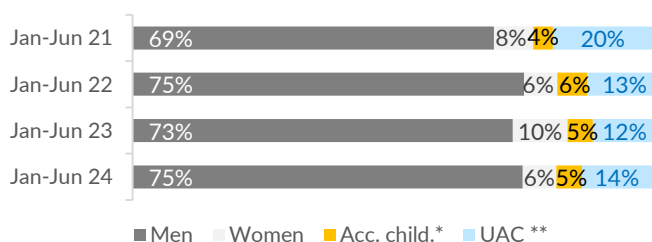

## Demographics of arrivals

In the first half of 2024, most people arriving by sea were adult males (75%), followed by unaccompanied children (UAC, 14%), adult females (6%) and accompanied children (5%).

In June, 292 adult females reached Italian shores, mainly originating from the Syrian Arab Republic (44), Afghanistan (33), Tunisia (29), Guinea and Nigeria (27 each).

In the same month, 584 UAC arrived in Italy by sea. The main nationalities were Gambian (117), Tunisian (71), Egyptian (62) and Eritrean (55).
