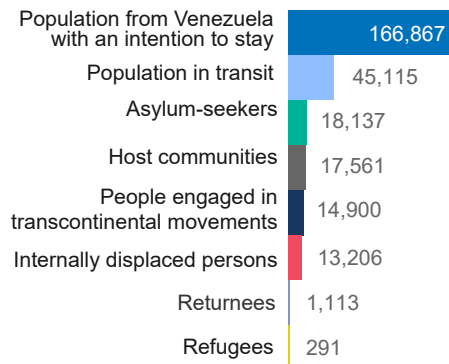

During 2024, UNHCR complemented the efforts of local and national authorities to respond to the humanitarian needs of populations requiring protection and their host communities.

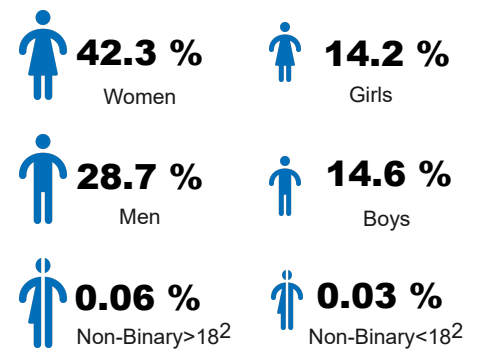

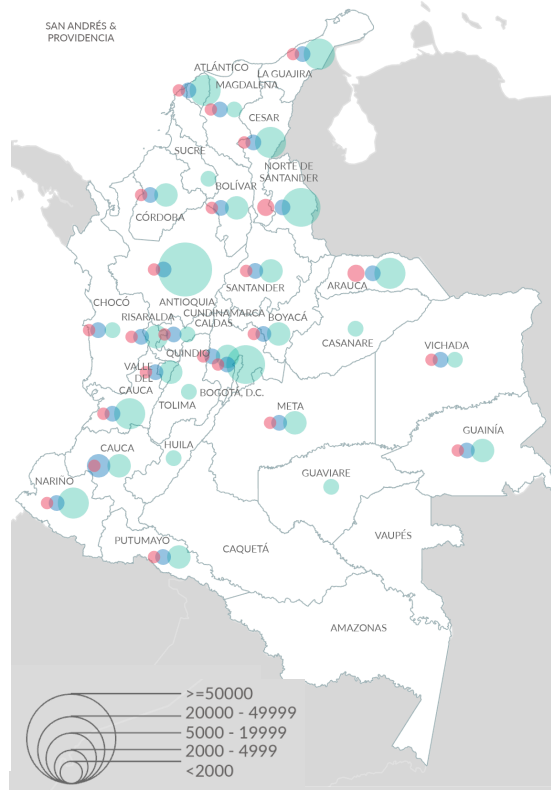

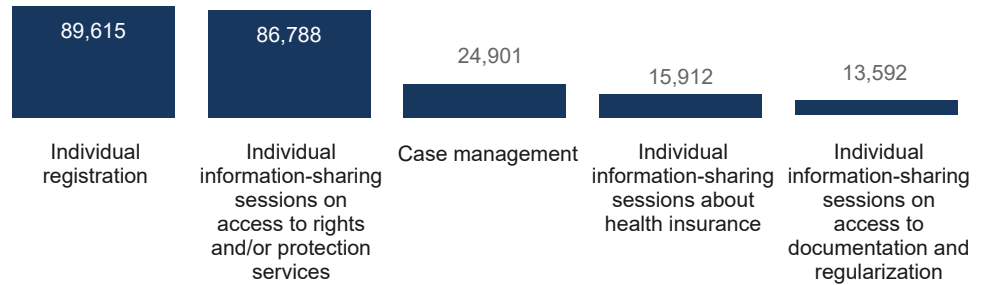
PROTECT

Access a fair and efficient protection system, in line with universal and regional standards, that guarantees the rights of the people with and for whom UNHCR works.

Acces to rights and protection services

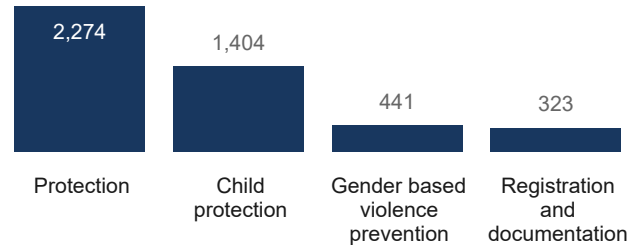

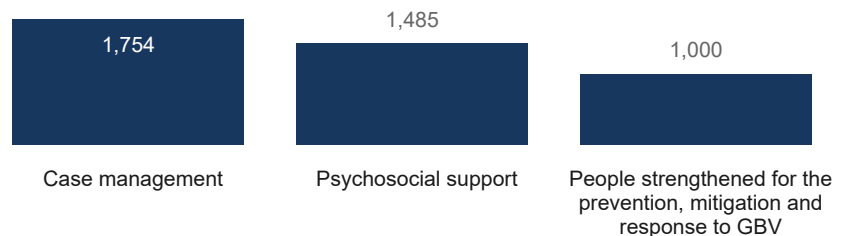
Through multisectoral support in technical, financial, and human resources, **institutions are strengthened** to respond to the needs of individuals with and for whom UNHCR works.

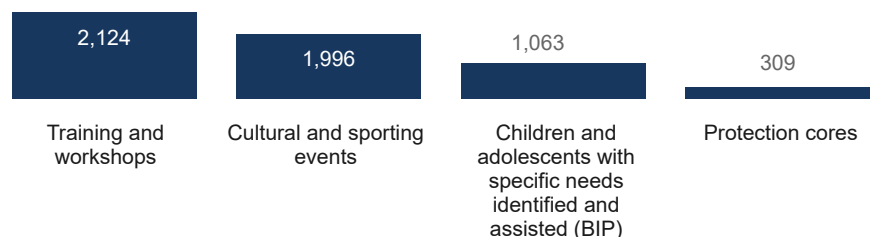
Gender based violence (GBV) prevention

Survivors of gender-based violence have **timely and adequate access to specialized protection services**. Additionally, interventions aim to prevent and mitigate the risks of gender-based violence.

Children are **protected from all forms of violence, exploitation, abuse, and discrimination**, and have access to child protection systems and child-friendly procedures, through activities designed to prevent, mitigate, and respond to the risks they face.

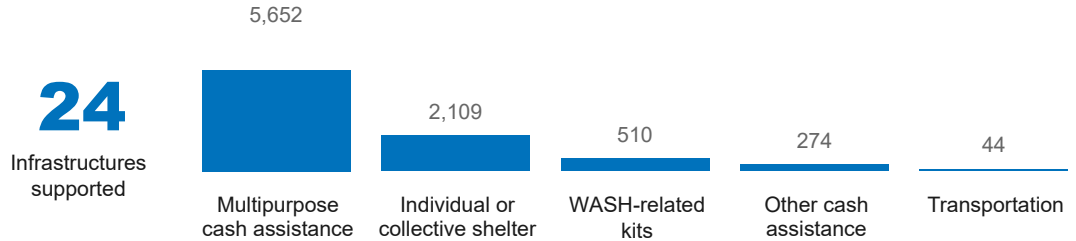
ASSIST

Multisectoral support is provided to individuals with and for whom UNHCR works to ensure timely and adequate access to services and assistance to meet their immediate needs.



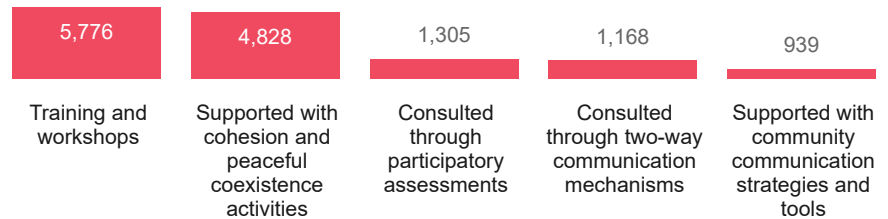
EMPOWER

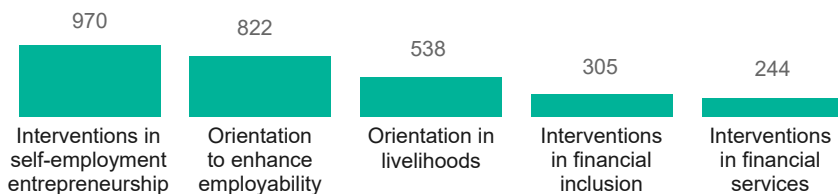
SOLVE
