Profile of persons on the move

The individuals moving cross-border within the region include vulnerable profiles with the top three being those with Serious medical condition (24%), Disability (22%) and Single parent (20%). On a socio-economic overview, there are unemployed (14%), student (37%) and skilled (28%). The top three recorded skills include Market-oriented Skilled Agricultural Workers (27%), Agricultural, Forestry and Fishery Labourers (19%) and Personal Services Workers (11%). Language proficiencies include Swahili (27%), English (16%) and Nyanja (9%).
