

ITALY Sea arrivals dashboard

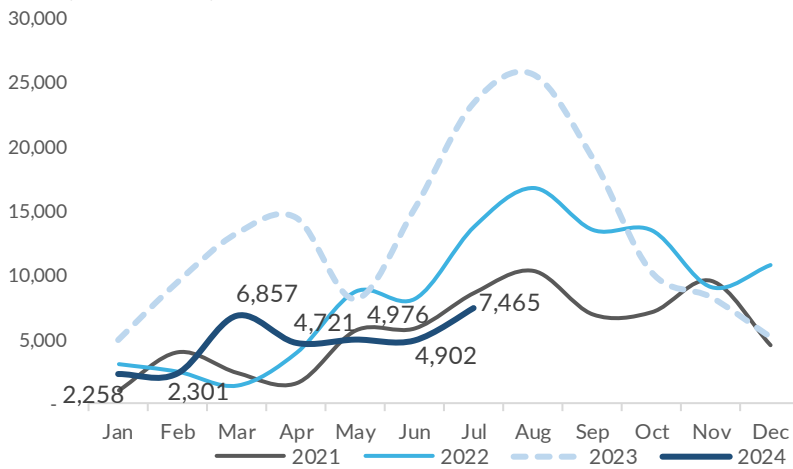
Overview

In the first seven months of 2024, 33,480 refugees and migrants arrived in Italy by sea, compared to 88,939 in the same period last year, a decrease of 62 per cent. Most of the 7,465 people who arrived in July disembarked in Sicily (5,352), followed by Tuscany (487), Calabria (341), Liguria (331), Sardinia (274), Apulia (249), Lazio (178), Campania (154), Emilia Romagna and Marche (34) and Abruzzo (14).

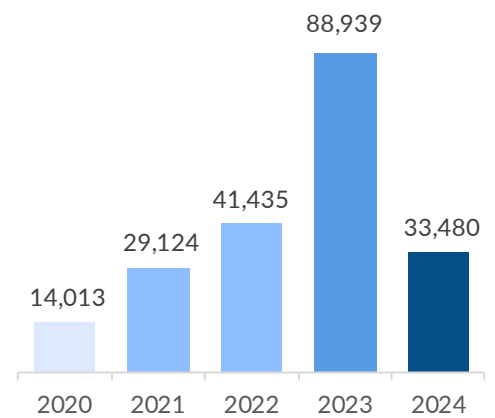
Monthly sea arrivals

Yearly sea arrivals

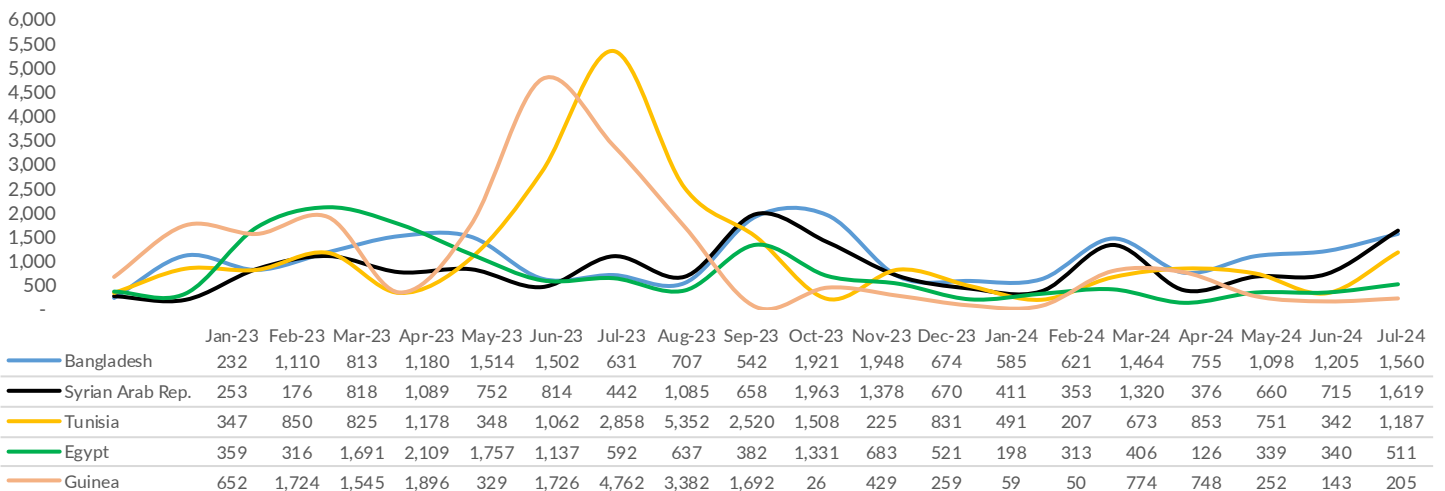
January to July, 2020-2024



Nationality of arrivals

In July, Syrians accounted for 22 per cent of all arrivals by sea (15% in June), followed by 21 per cent Bangladeshis (25% in June) and 16 per cent Tunisians (7% in June). Among other nationalities of people arriving in significant numbers by sea were Egyptian (7%), Algerian (4%), Iranian (3%), Eritrean, Ethiopian, Guinean, Nigerian and Pakistani (3% each). In July, the main nationalities of those departing from Libya were Syrian (32%, 22% in June), Bangladeshi (31%, 38% in June) and Egyptian (10%, 9% in June). Most of those departing from Tunisia were Tunisian (65%, 30% in June), Guinean (10%, 12% in June) and Malian (4%, 6 in June). Most of those departing from Türkiye were Iranian (60%, 33% in June), Iraqi (32%, 10% in June) and Afghan (5%, 27% in June). All those departing from Algeria were Algerian (100%, 96% in June).

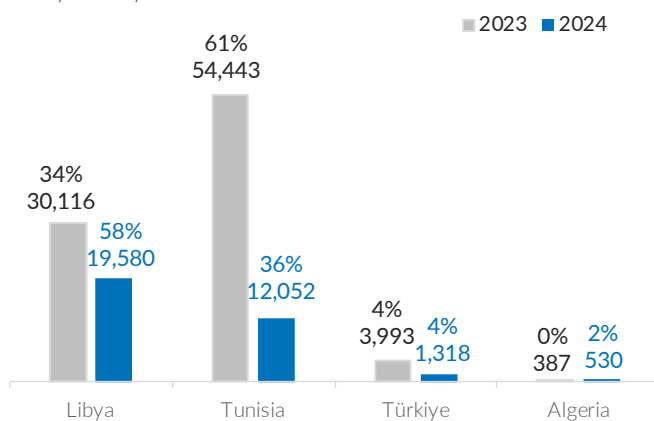
Most common nationalities of people arriving by sea - January 2023 to July 2024



Country of embarkation

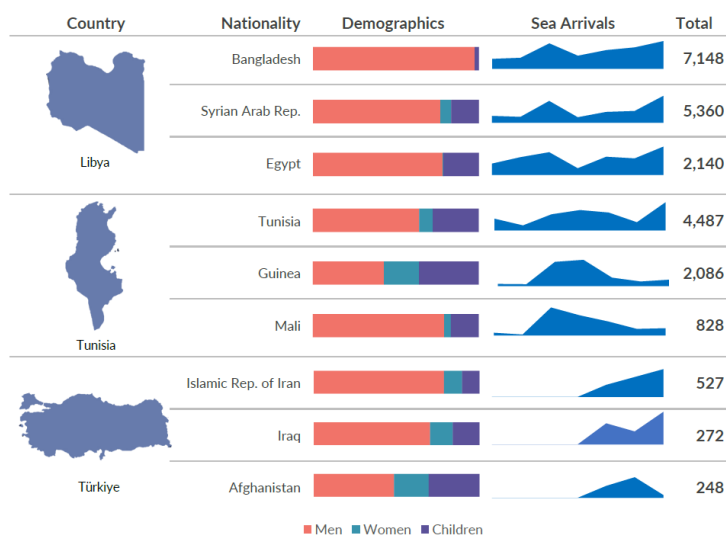
In the first seven months of 2024, 58 per cent of the people reaching Italy via sea departed from Libya (19,580 people in 384 landings), followed by 36 per cent from Tunisia (12,052 people in 406 landings), 4 per cent from Türkiye (1,318 people in 20 landings), and 2 per cent from Algeria (530 people in 51 landings). In July, as in June, Libya was the main country of departure (accounting for 67% of people landing in Italy), followed by Tunisia (24%), Türkiye (5%) and Algeria (3%).

January to July 2023 - 2024



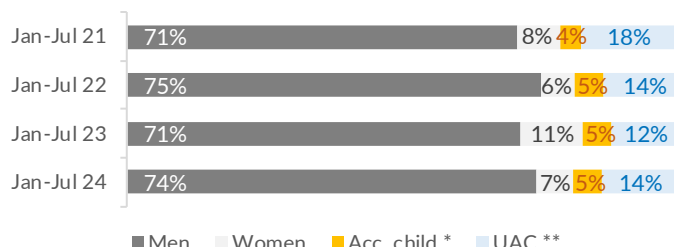

In the first seven months of 2024, most people arriving by sea were adult males (74%), followed by unaccompanied children (UAC, 14%), adult females (7%) and accompanied children (5%).

In July, 518 adult females reached Italian shores, mainly originating from Tunisia (122), the Syrian Arab Republic (111), Guinea (39) and Nigeria (38).

In the same month, 1,012 UAC arrived in Italy by sea. The main nationalities were Tunisian (230), Syrian (115), Ethiopian (110) and Egyptian (106).
