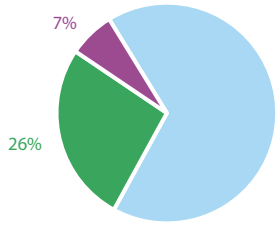

Data will be updated each quarter

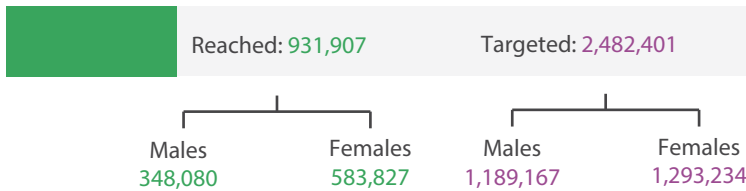
