

WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) decreased from 972,300 last week to 966,100 this week.

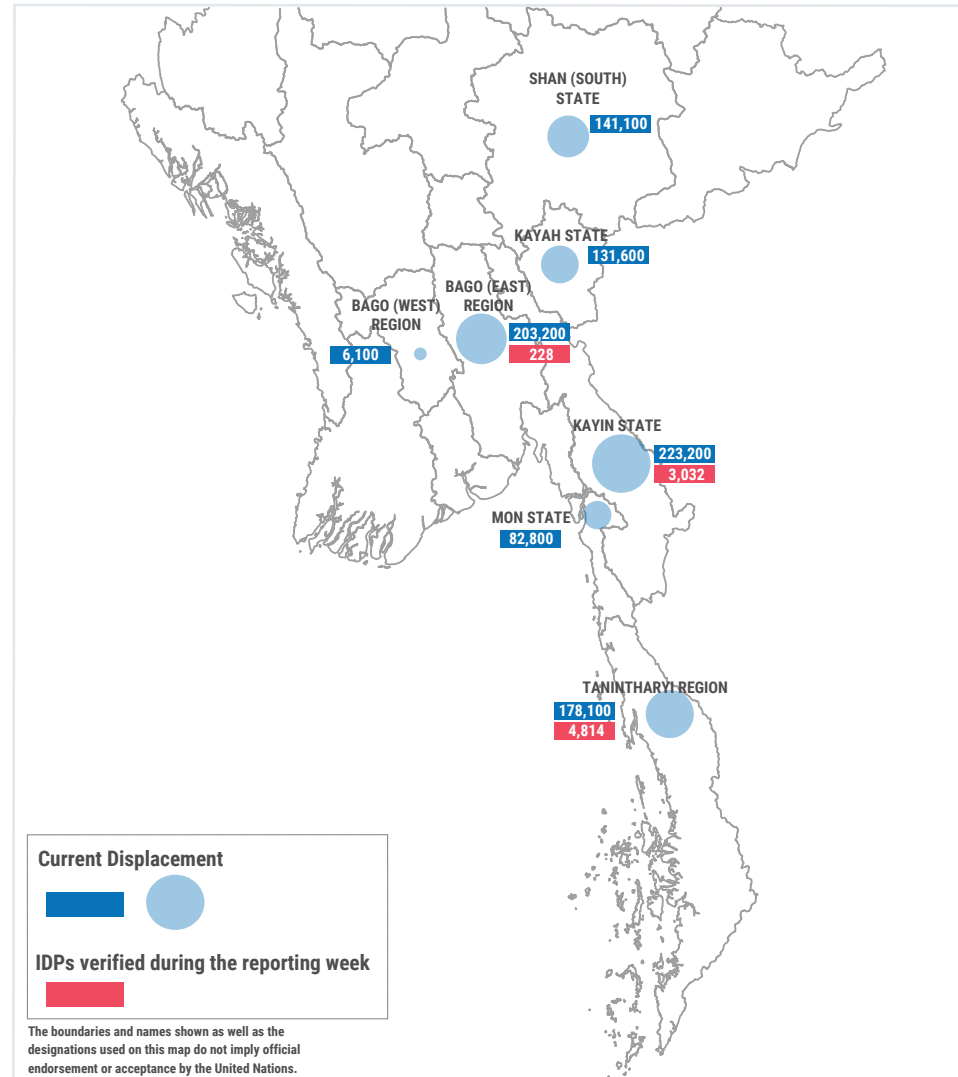
In Kayin State, 3,000 people from Yae Pu Gyi village, in Kawkareik Township, were displaced within the same township due to airstrikes and artillery shelling, and 32 people from Thar Moe Taung Village, in Thandaunggyi Township, were displaced within the same township due to indiscriminate shelling.

In Bago Region (East), 228 people from Yedashe Township were displaced within the same township due to a drone attack and clashes.

In Tanintharyi Region, 4,814 people from Auk Yae Hpyu Village, in Launglon Township, were forced to flee within the same township due to a Tatmadaw's troop reinforcement and indiscriminate shelling. On the other hand, 12,073 IDPs from Launglon Township and 2,292 IDPs from Tanintharyi Township returned to their places of origin.

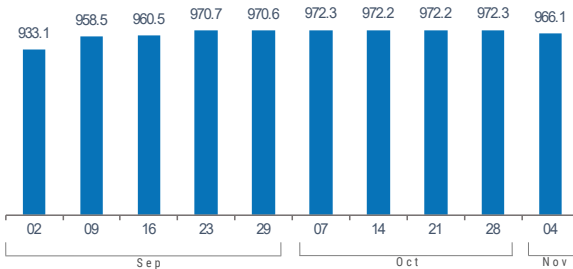

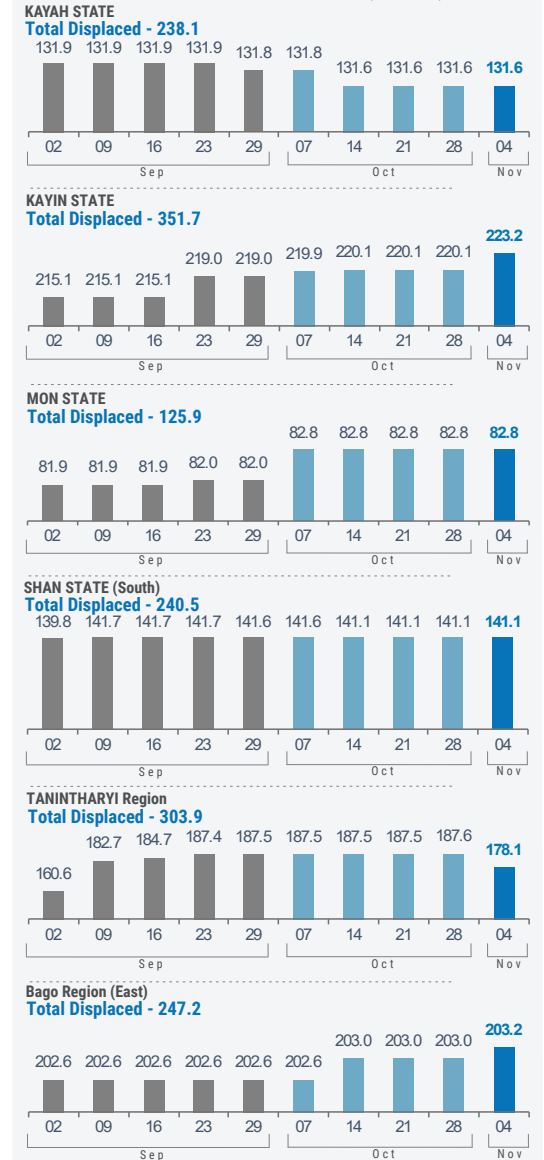
