1. **Update on 2024 Socio-Economic Insights Survey**

IMWG co-chair (UNHCR) updated on the 2024 Socio-Economic Insights Survey (SEIS), implemented in Slovakia coordinated by UNHCR in collaboration with IOM, WHO and UNICEF, supported by SHC and the Slovak Academy of Science. SEIS is an annual interagency regional collaborative process, within the framework of the Regional Refugee Response Plan for the Ukraine Situation (RRP), to identify the most pressing needs of the refugee population in Slovakia across various sectors such as protection, health, education, shelter, livelihoods, food security and others. The assessment provides an evidence base to inform the planning and prioritization process, ensuring the needs and vulnerabilities of different refugee groups are understood.

In this regard, UNHCR organized on the 24th of September 2024 a Round Table event in Bratislava, to provide the opportunity to different actors involved in the refugee response to discuss the findings of the 2024 SEIS, by highlighting the importance of data and coordination of assessments in addressing the needs of refugees. The round table facilitated discussions among the participating entities, establishing a common overview and understanding for a unified situation analysis, and exploring potential synergies and further cooperation in the area of data analysis and research.

Action Points;

IMWG co-chair (UNHCR) will share the presentation with the preliminary results with the IMWG members, and the report once published end of November.

2. **2025/26 RRP Process**

IMWG co-chair (UNHCR) updated on the 2025/26 RRP in Slovakia; express of interest and project appeal processes have finalized with a total of 19 RRP partners (13 National NGOs, 1 International NGO and 5 UN Agencies), and a total financial requirement for both years of USD 79.4 M (USD 42.5M for 2025 and USD 36.9M for 2026).

3. **2025/26 RRP Regional and country indicators**

IMWG co-chair (UNHCR) provided an update on the new [regional indicators](#) and the proposed country indicators for Slovakia for the next years of RRP. The shared framework includes the indicators, and the proposed breakdown for each, by region, age and gender. The compilation of inputs from the RRP partners was presented and reviewed by the IMWG members, that provided additional comments to the country indicators.

Action Points;

IMWG co-chair (UNHCR) will compile all final comments and share the final version of the country indicators with RRP partners and IMWG members.
