

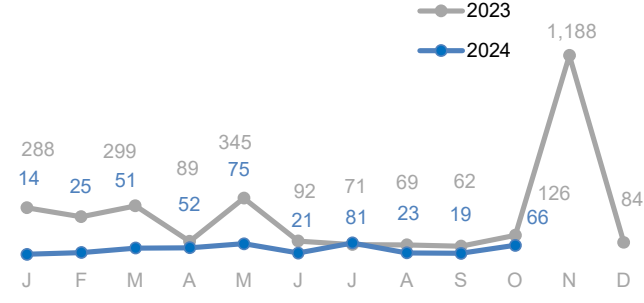

TOTAL DISPLACEMENTS

66,000 in Oct
427,000 (Jan - Oct 2024)
2,949,000 (Jan - Dec 2023)

The UNHCR-led PSMN implemented in partnership with NRC reported **66,000** internal displacements in the month of October 2024. Out of these, **50,000** were caused by conflict or insecurity, **1,000** were drought related and **2,000** were displaced by floods. Approximately **13,000** were displaced due to other reasons

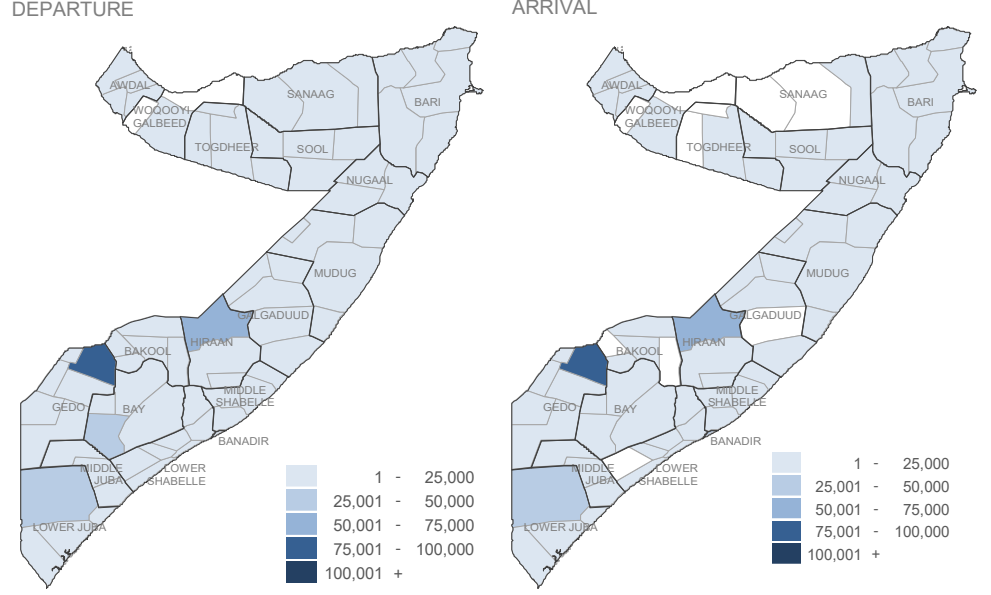

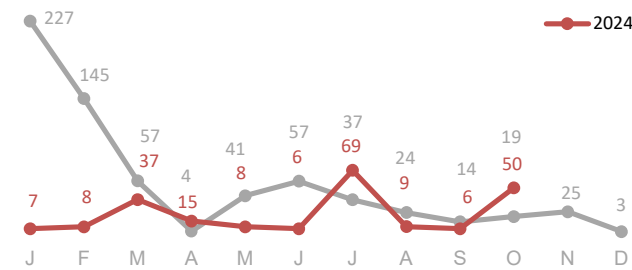
CONFLICT / INSECURITY DISPLACEMENTS

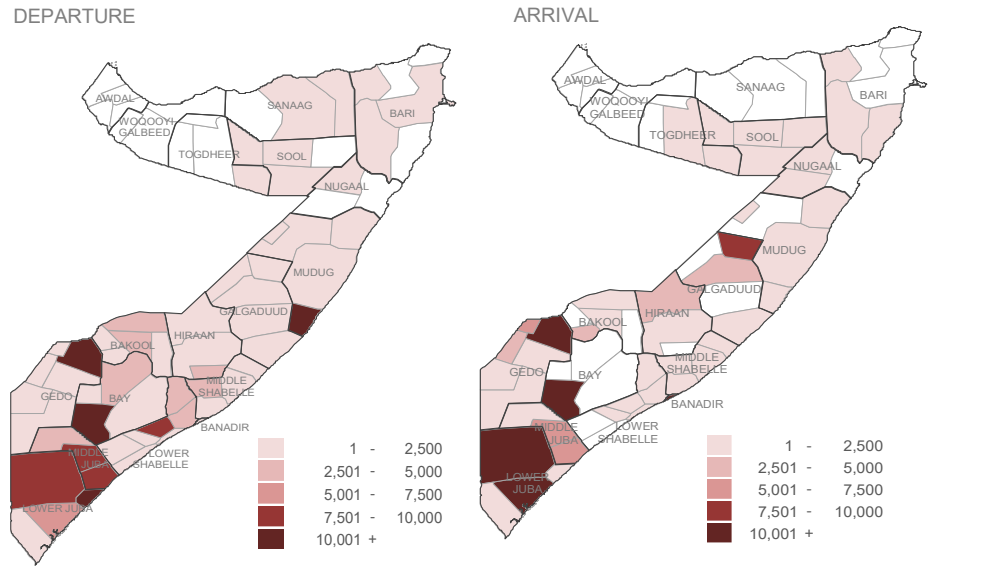

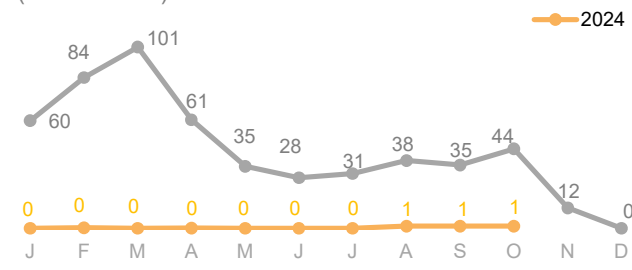
DROUGHT RELATED DISPLACEMENTS

Major displacement departures owing to drought also occurred in **Laas Caanood** (400) and **Buuhoodle** (500) districts.

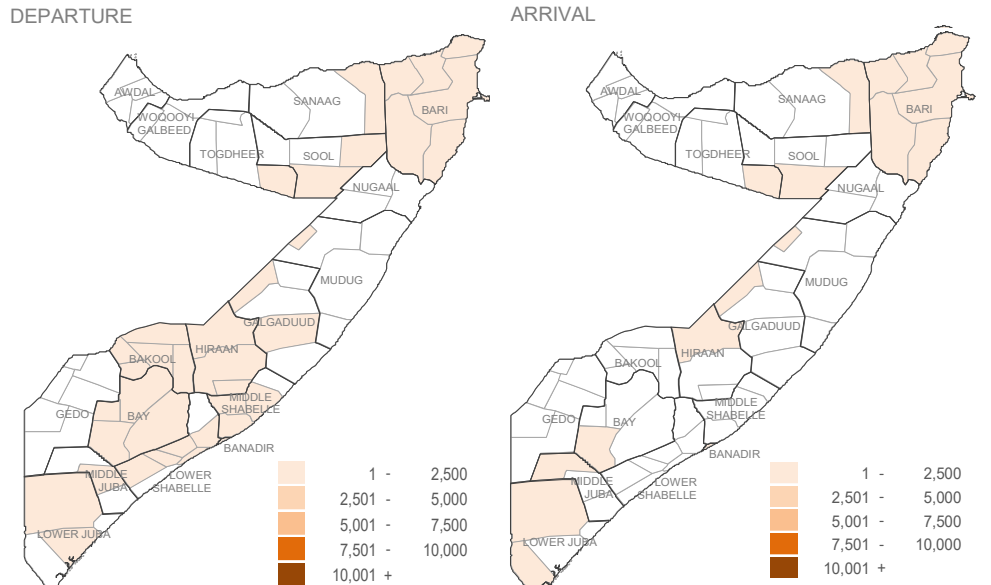

BY DISTRICT (Jan - Oct 2024)



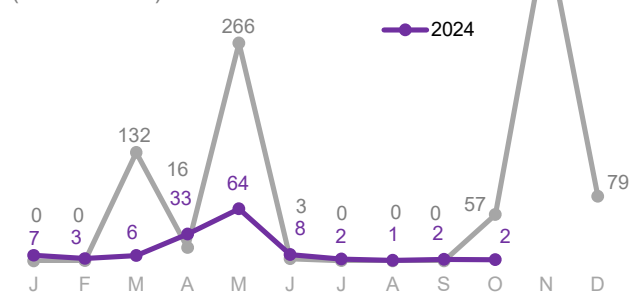
FLOOD DISPLACEMENTS

Major displacement departures due to floods occurred in **Balacad** (1200) and **Jowhar** (250) in Middle Shabelle region

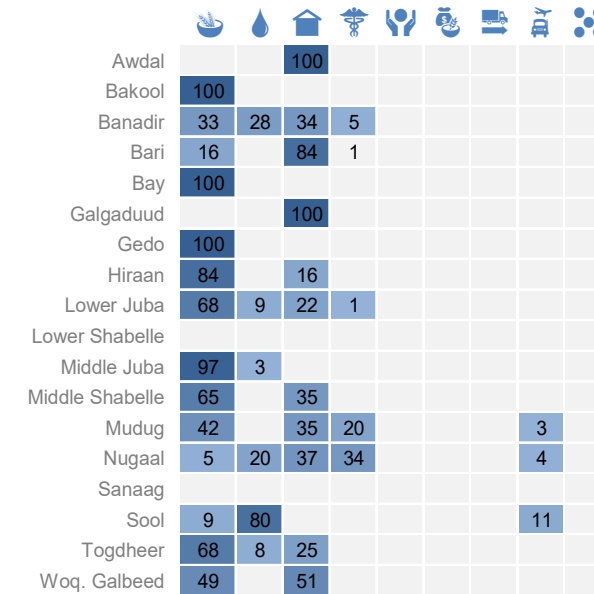

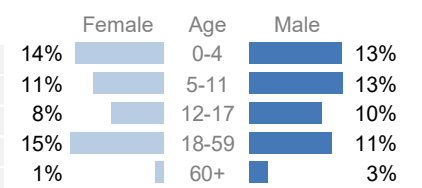

About PRMN

The PSMN (Protection & Solutions Monitoring Network) is a UNHCR-led project which identifies and reports on displacements (including returns) of populations in Somalia. The network also identifies and reports on protection risks and incidents underlying such movements. Only figures collected by PSMN are reported above. Not all displacements in Somalia are captured. This dashboard should be read in conjunction with the Notes on PSMN Methodology (<https://data2.unhcr.org/en/documents/details/53888>) which outline the approach and certain limitations. The figures shown are for numbers of displacements/individuals and are based on interviews with key informants and/or displaced households at destination (unless otherwise noted).
