This visual representation serves as a vital tool for understanding the dynamics of Afghan nationals return, aiding stakeholders in making informed decisions and assessments regarding their integration and support.

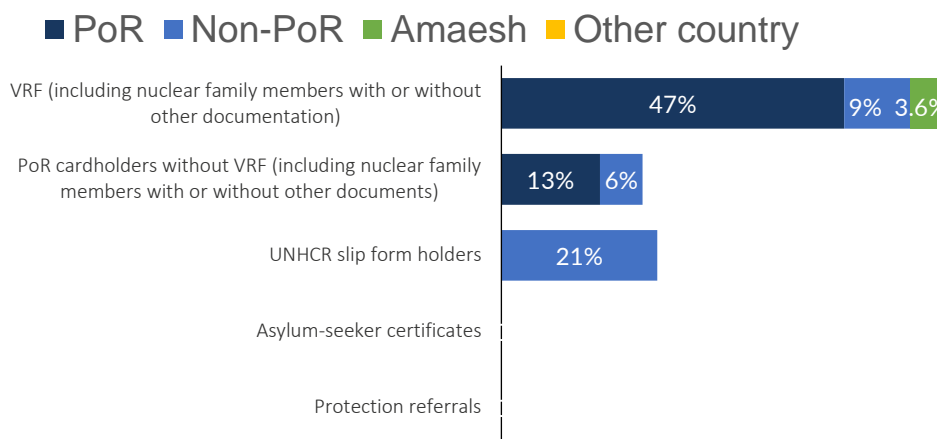


Age and gender analysis of returnees

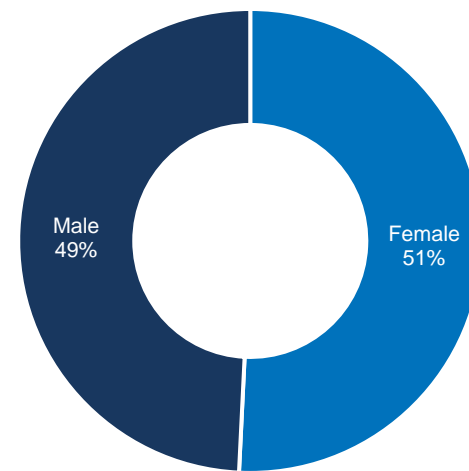
- **51%** of returnees are female

Returns by documentation type



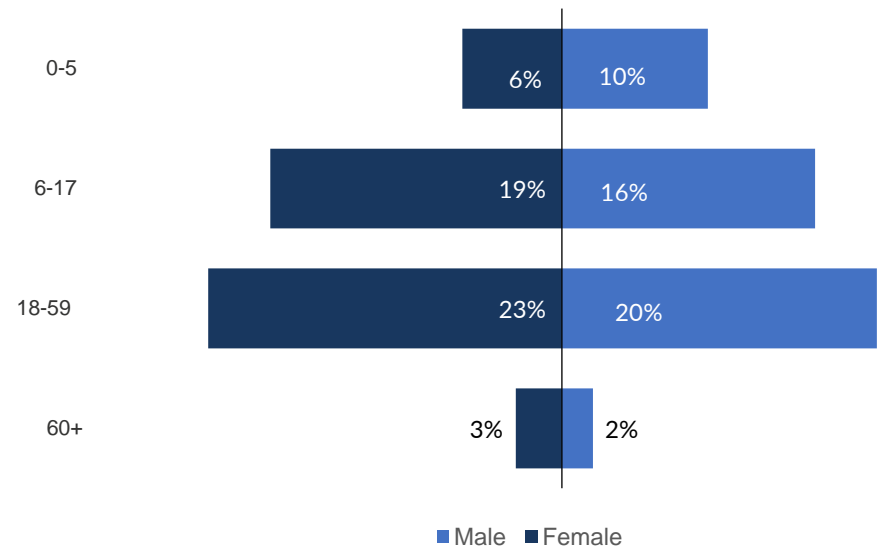
Gender breakdown of returnees



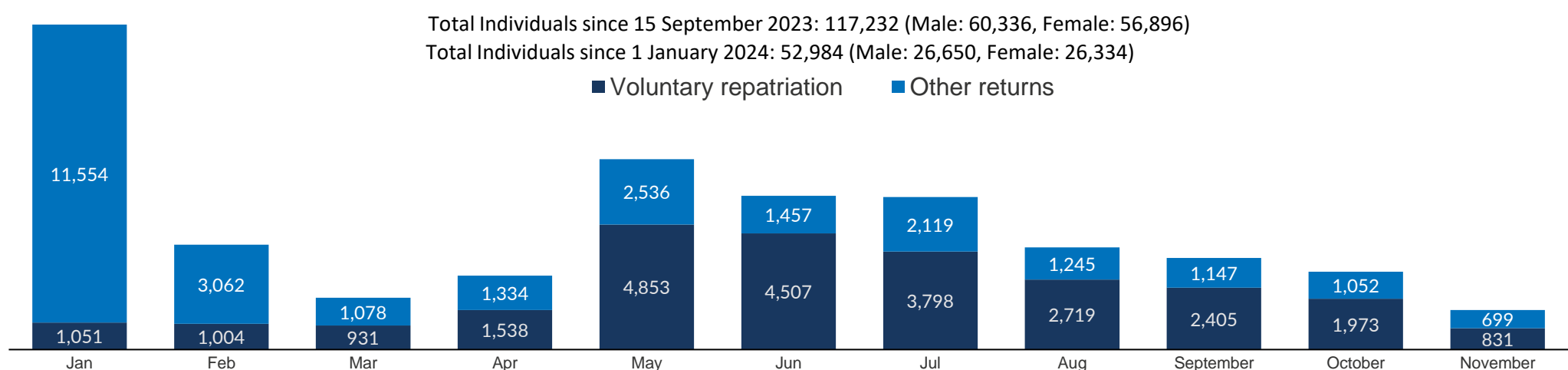
