# Highlights from MHPSS tWG in 2024

Mental Health Forum: Co-organized by the MoH and WHO Poland, Warsaw, 6-7 June 2024

## Objectives of the Forum:

- bring together and catalyse the **engagement of a wide range of multisectoral stakeholders in mental health** to encourage their active participation and long-term commitment to implementing the transformation of the mental health system;
- to **facilitate a pivotal revitalization of the Polish Mental Health Coalition** to promote an intersectoral approach to addressing mental health challenges;
- to **discuss options for intersectoral governance** models for mental health;
- to **address key national priorities** for mental health, including child and youth mental health and well-being and the transition towards community-based mental health care; and
- to **discuss and reach agreement on the draft Consensus Statement** for the development of a comprehensive Intersectoral Roadmap for National Mental Health.



# Highlights from MHPSS tWG 2024

**National Mental Health Protection Programme 2023-2030 Roadmap is a comprehensive, intersectoral implementation plan of the National Mental Health Protection Programme 2023-2030 → Sustainability of MHPSS for Ukrainian refugees is 1 of 7 key priorities**

## **Proposed actions:**

- **Enhance access to MHPSS services** for children, focusing on a comprehensive approach that includes prevention, promotion, specialized services, and continued support.
- **Strengthen system** by integrating MHPSS services for refugees and vulnerable groups and host populations, foster social cohesion and integration of refugees into society.
- **Strengthen and enhance intersectoral cooperation** within government and between government and civil society ensuring a smooth transition of MHPSS services from emergency response to government lead.

# Way Forward – MHPSS tWG 2025

- **Strengthen coordination and collaboration:** In-person meeting in January 2025
- **Joint Advocacy:** facilitate Roadmap implementation in support of the Government
- **Continued sharing of good practices and tools:** i.e. expert webinars
- **Joint trainings and capacity-strengthening**
- **Cross-sectorial engagement:** Beyond Protection and Health sectors
