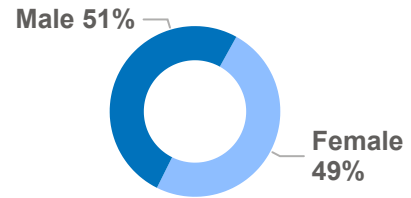


Refugees and Asylum-seekers Movement and Presence

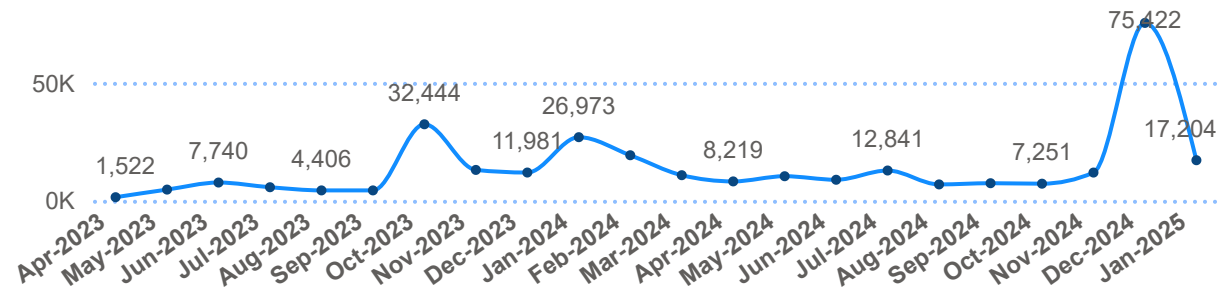

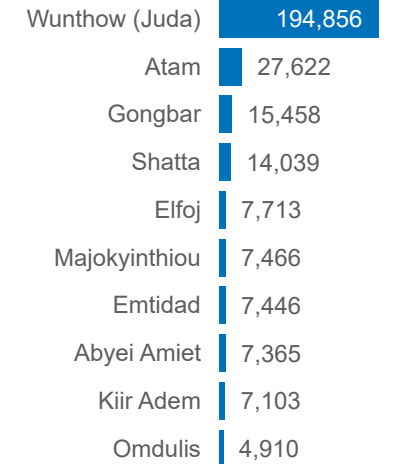

17,204 refugee and asylum-seeker arrived in January 2025


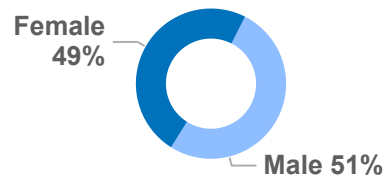
Individuals arrived by top ten border points
