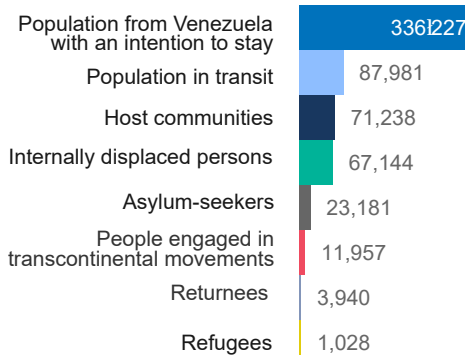

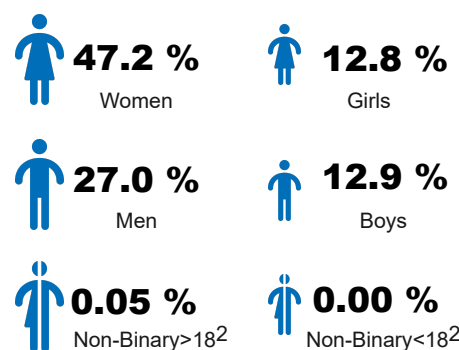
During 2024, UNHCR complemented the efforts of local and national authorities to respond to the humanitarian needs of populations requiring protection and their host communities.

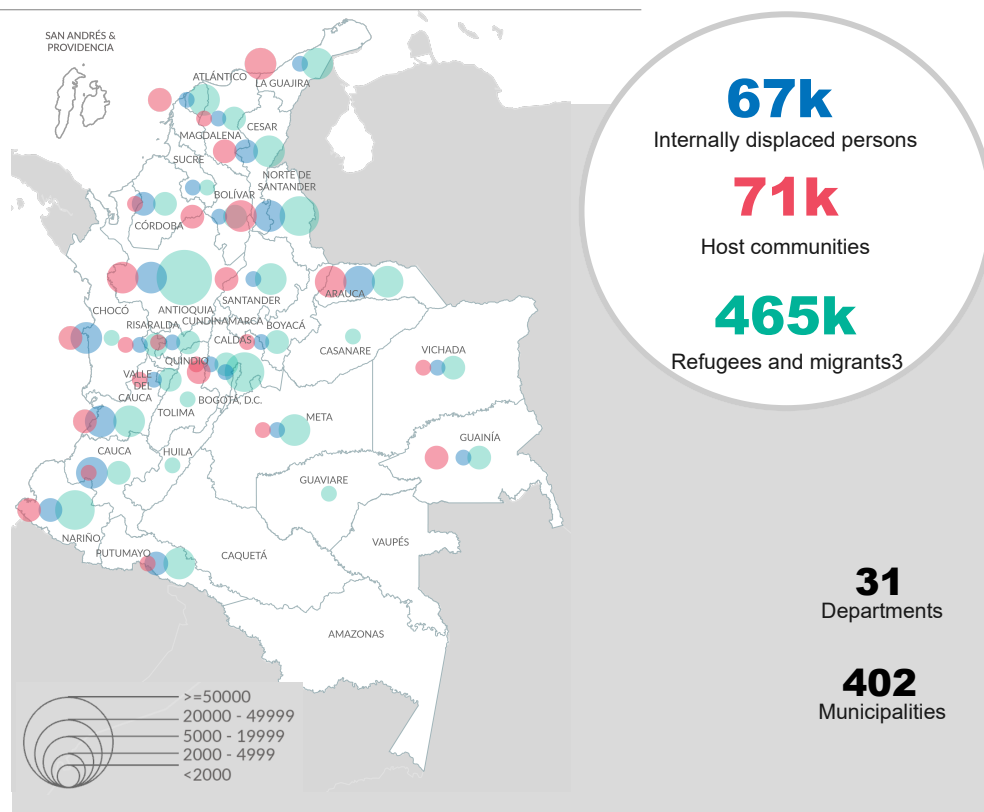
People with and for whom UNHCR works

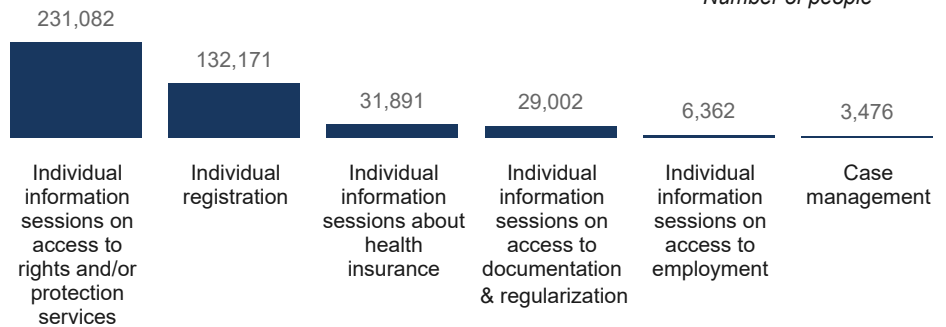
Access a fair and efficient protection system, in line with universal and regional standards, that guarantees the rights of the people with and for whom UNHCR works.
