


During 2024, UNHCR complemented the efforts of local and national authorities to respond to the humanitarian needs of populations requiring protection and their host communities.

Access to rights and services for individuals with and for whom UNHCR works is promoted through guidance, documentation, case management, and protection monitoring, which helps identify the needs of the population.






