Fourteen years since the onset of the crisis, Syria is grappling with a catastrophe of unprecedented magnitude, with new developments adding to the existing crises and taking a heavy toll on the people living in Syria. Over 16 million people need help, and 7.4 million remain displaced inside the country. The challenges are overwhelming conflict, economic collapse, climate stress, and uncertainty about the future.

UNHCR is preparing for up to 1.5 million returns in 2025. With partners, provides critical support including legal aid protection interventions, Health, housing, and livelihood support to returnees, helping them rebuild their lives in their home country in a sustainable and secure setting
