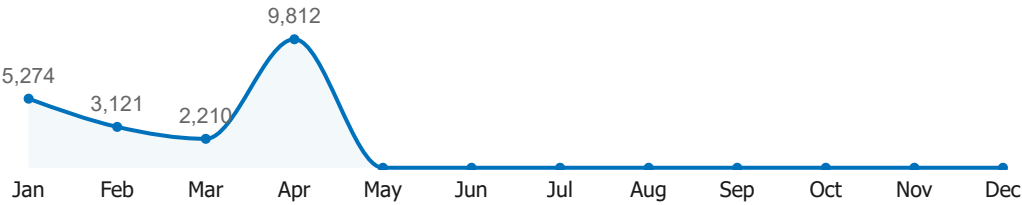


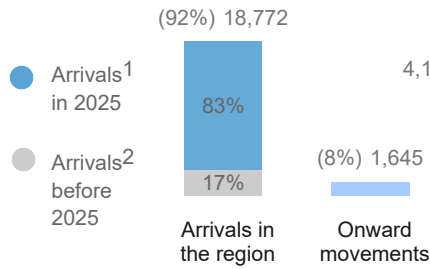

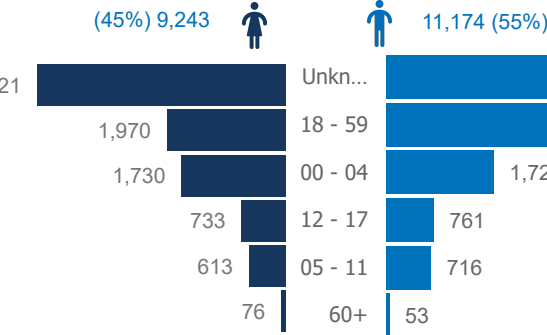
Trends by Month (in 2025)



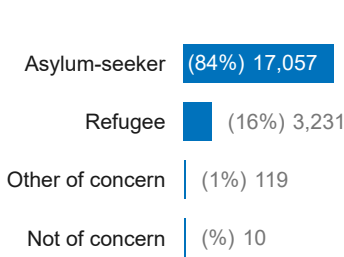
Types of Movement <sup>3</sup>



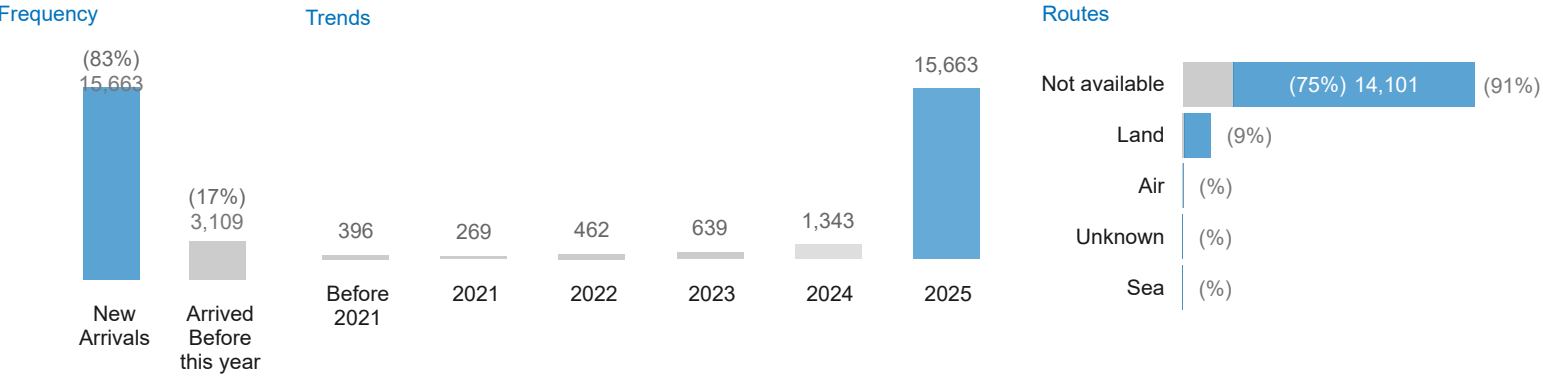

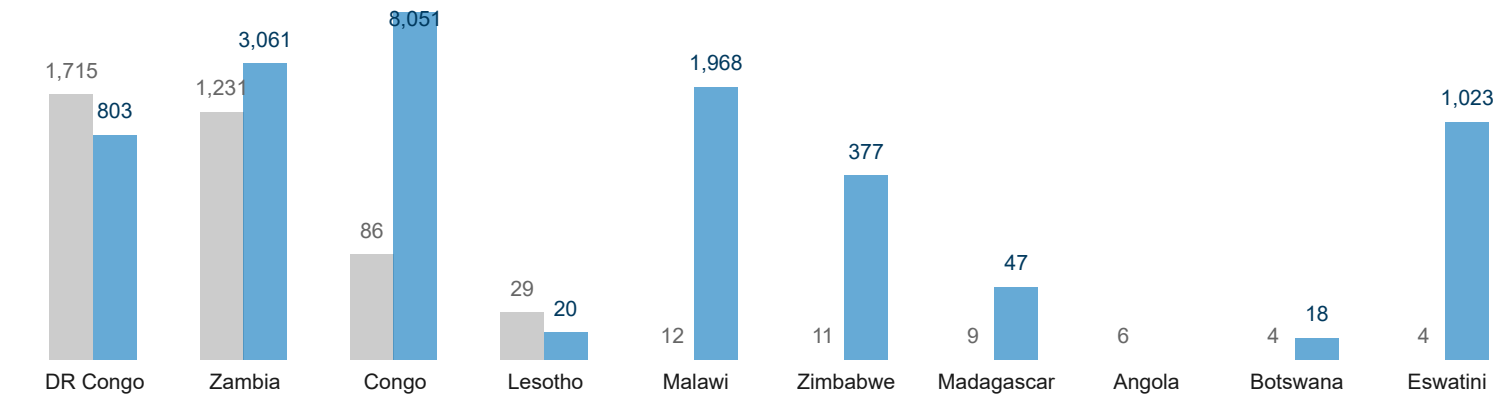

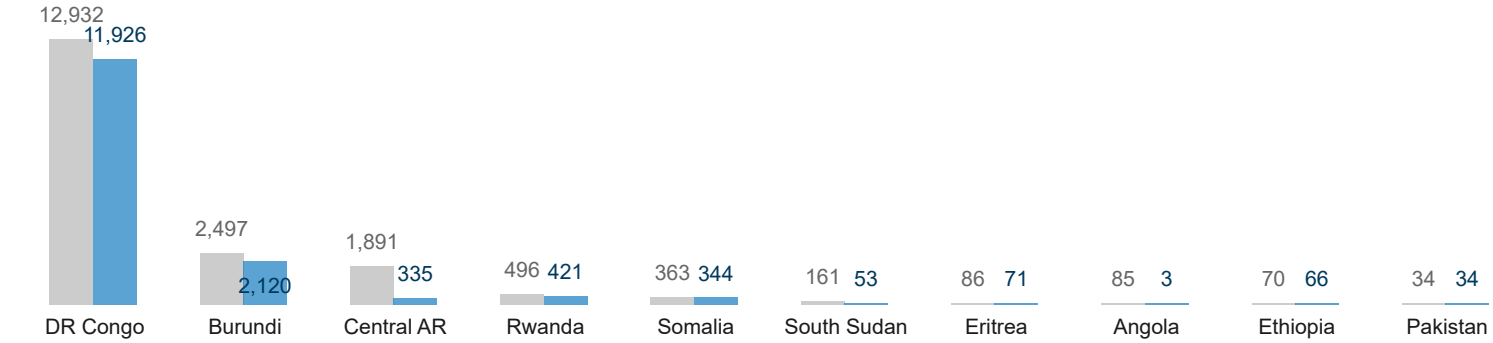
18,772 forcibly displaced persons arrived in the region and 7,617 were registered this year while 8,046 are yet to be registered.



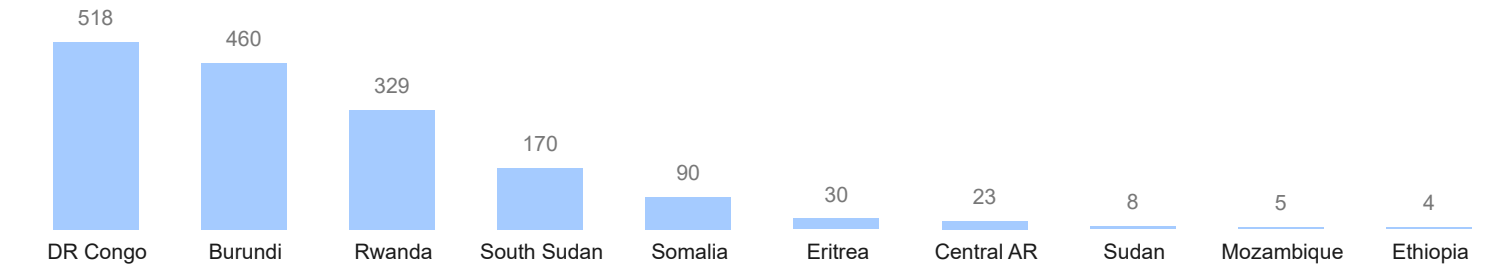
By Country of Asylum (top 10)
