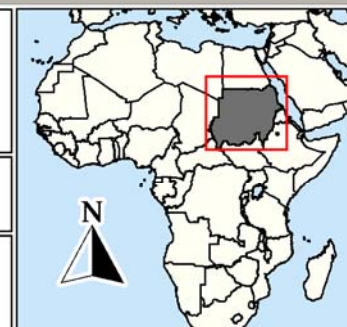

Situation:

- Over 86,320 persons have arrived in Sudan
- 54,099 persons have received humanitarian assistance (specific assistance only).
- Sudan hosts an estimated 350,000 Southern Sudanese individuals following the separation of South Sudan from Sudan.
