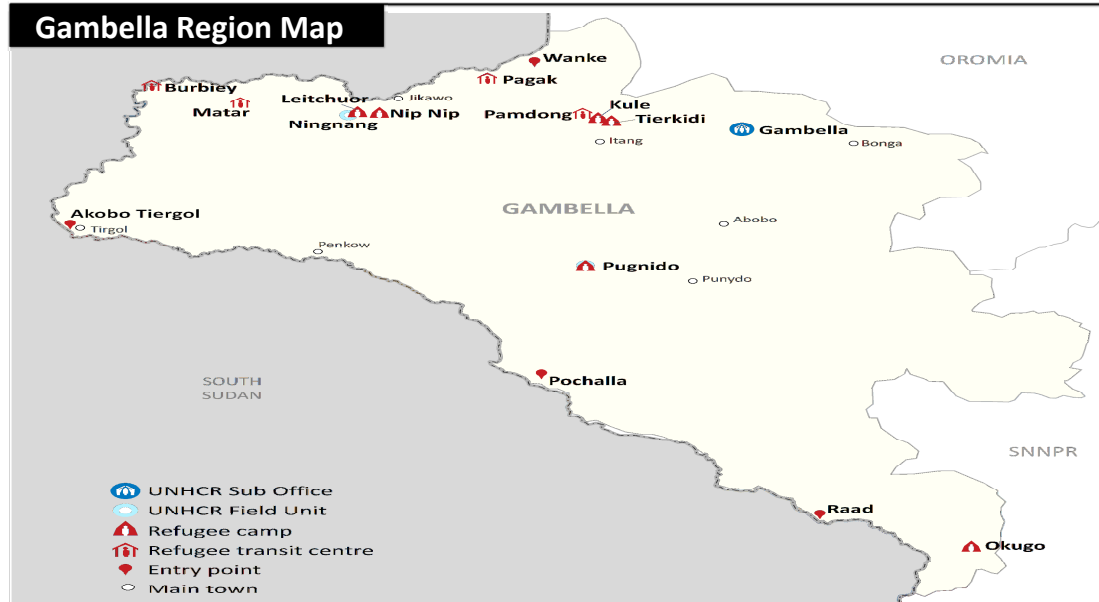


South Sudanese new arrivals in Gambella - Post 15th December 2013 (as of 29-Aug-2014)

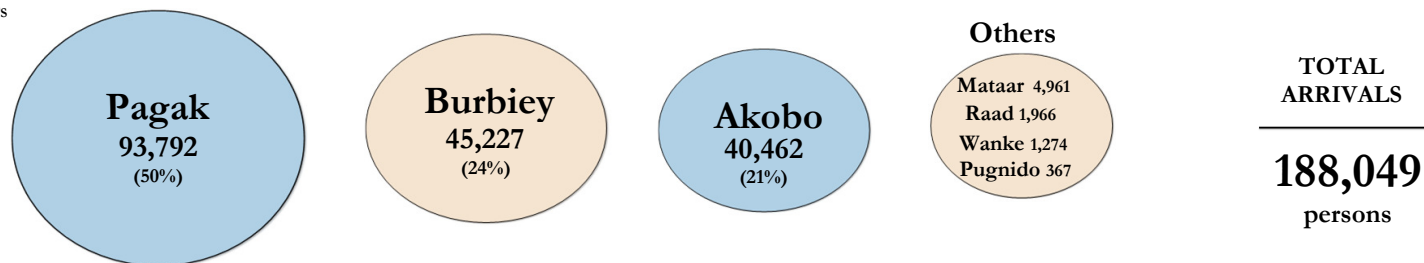

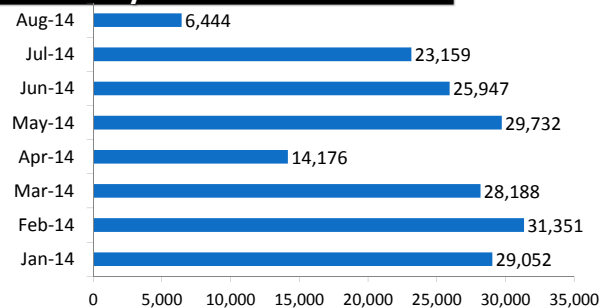
