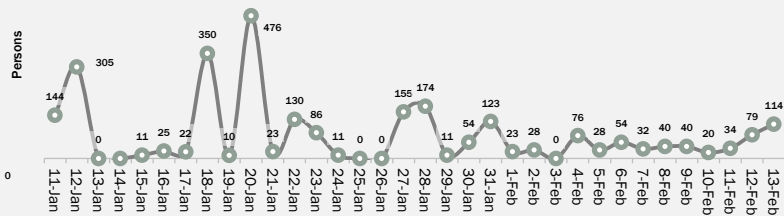


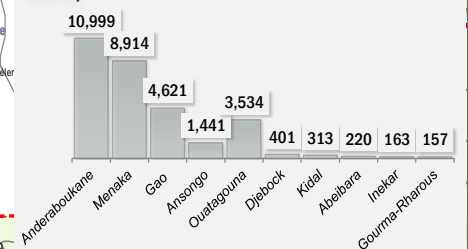
Niger currently hosts an estimated 50,000 Malian refugees. The crisis has also led to the return of over 3,000 nationals of Niger previously living in the Gao area in Mali. These displacements have occurred in a difficult period for Niger already facing a food crisis and devastating floodings which severely hit the country during the month of august. The operation focus on the following areas of action: guarantee the security and physical integrity; Ensure that all refugees are duly registered; secure access to basic necessities and livelihood; ensure an active participation and close involvement of refugees in programs and activities that affect their lives; bolster coordination and cooperation with all other stakeholders.

New Arrivals in Niger since 11 January 2013 by day

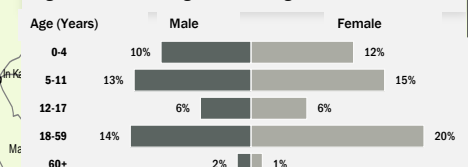
