

Context

History Sag-nioniogo was first established as a refugee site to host refugees fleeing the Mali conflict in the 1990s. The camp re-opened in October 2012 when the crisis flared up again in Mali. Refugees currently living in Sag-nioniogo were relocated from Somgande, a temporary schoolyard located in Ouagadougou on 15 October, 2012. Refugees and host populations share water, schools, and a local health services.

Protection Responses

Women's committee formed by **IEDA-Relief** to address women's issues.

CONAREF provides eight security agents to secure the camp.

Minorities in various elected committees installed by **IEDA-Relief** and **CONAREF**.

Local primary health center maintained by **French Red Cross** improved conditions.

Firewood distribution by **OCADES/Caritas** and solar lamps by **Monaco Red Cross**.

Mobile courts introduced by **CONAREF** have registered 31 newborns.

Both **Terre des Hommes** and **IEDA-Relief** provided income generating activities.

Local Conflict Resolution committees established for mediation purposes by **CONAREF**.

Community gardens are established by operational partner **ADRA**.

The Luxembourg Red Cross is installing a modern water system in the camp.
