




**United Nations Country Team in Turkey
Daily Situation Report on the Situation Pertaining to Syria**

April 2, 2012


- ❖ It has been reported that total camp population is reached to **19,047** with the arrival of 395 persons and the return of 18 persons.
- ❖ Increase in the arrivals from December 16, 2011 to April 1, 2012 is reflected below.



- ❖ Currently arrivals from Syria are assisted in the border provinces of Hatay, Gaziantep, and Kilis.
- ❖ As of April 2, 2012 the city breakdown in the region is as follows:
 - Hatay population^{*} : 8,602 individuals
 - Gaziantep population in Islahiye[†]: 3,481 individuals.
 - Kilis population in Öncüpınar container site: 6,964 individuals
- ❖ Population movement from Hatay to Gaziantep (Islahiye Camp), Kilis (Öncüpınar Container site), from 15 March[†] to 1 April 2012 is reflected below.

^{*} : The population of the Kuyubaşı/Karbeyaz, Yayladagi 2 (YİBO), Altınözü I (TEKEL), Reyhanlı camps in Hatay is moved to Islahiye camp in Gaziantep and to Öncüpınar container site in Kilis. It has been reported that the empty camps will be kept for while as standby.

[†] : There are two locations in Islahiye; Nurdağı Sport Center and Islahiye tent city but population figure is for all.

1. Highlights:

- ❖ More than 80 countries gathered in Istanbul for the weekend Conference of the Group of Friends of Syria, urged the Syrian regime to stop immediately attacks against civilians. The Conference expressed its support for the plan by the SG's Special Envoy, Mr. Kofi Annan, but requested for its immediate implementation. U.S. Secretary of State, Hillary Clinton thanked Turkey at a press conference following the Conference, for protecting Syrians fleeing from the conflict.
- ❖ It has been reported in local paper **Zafer** that the whole population of the camp - Altinözü (TEKEL) that Angelina Jolie visited is in transfer to Kilis.
