

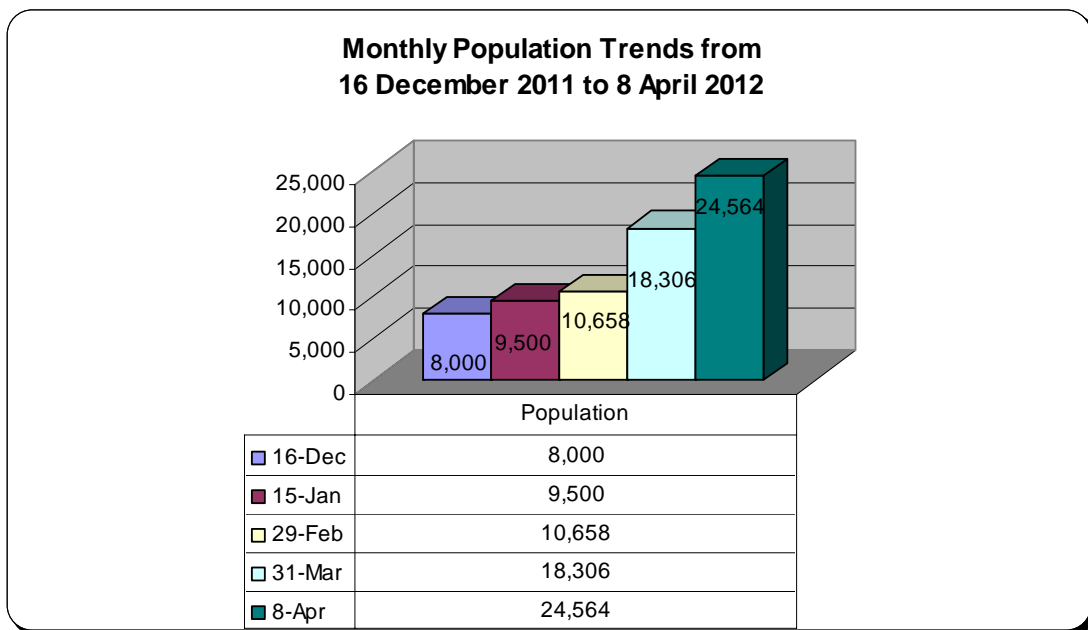


United Nations Country Team in Turkey
Daily Situation Report on the Situation Pertaining to Syria

April 8, 2012

It has been reported that total camp population is reached to **24,564** with the arrival of 193 persons and the return of 182 persons.

Increase in the arrivals from December 16, 2011 to April 8, 2012 is reflected below.



Currently arrivals from Syria are assisted in the border provinces of Hatay, Gaziantep, Kilis and Şanlıurfa.

As of April 8, 2012 the city breakdown in the region is as follows:

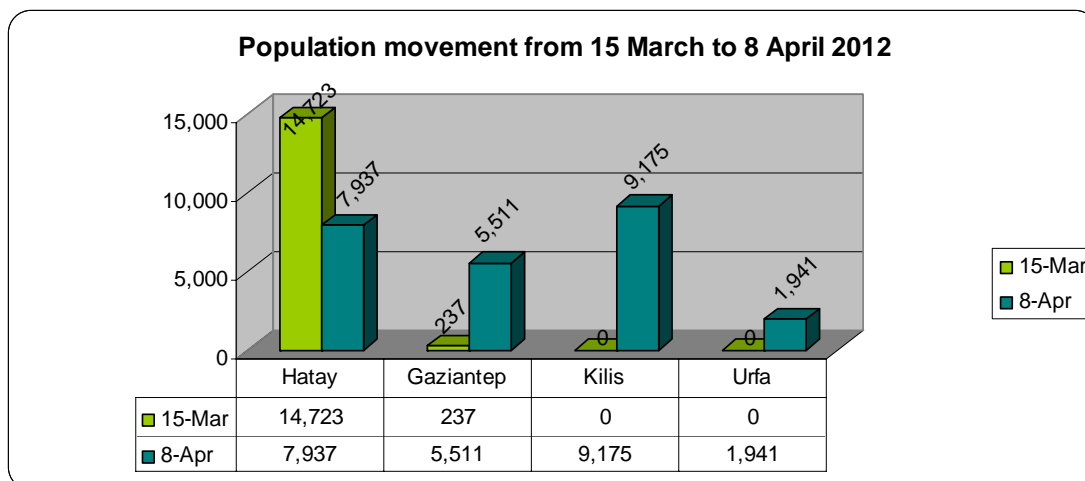
- ❖ Hatay population^{*}: 7,935 individuals
- ❖ Gaziantep population in İslahiye[†]: 5,511 individuals.
- ❖ Kilis population in Öncüpınar container site: 9,175 individuals
- ❖ Şanlıurfa population in Ceylanpınar: 1,941 individuals

Population movement from Hatay to Gaziantep (İslahiye Camp), Kilis (Öncüpınar Container site) and Şanlıurfa (Ceylanpınar), from 15 March[‡] to 8 April 2012 is reflected below.

^{*} : The population of the Kuyubaşı/Karbeyaz, Yayladağı 2 (YİBO), Altınözü I (TEKEL) and Reyhanlı camps in Hatay is moved to İslahiye camp in Gaziantep and to Öncüpınar container site in Kilis. It has been reported that these empty camps will be kept for while as standby.

[†] : There are two locations in İslahiye; Nurdağı Sport Center and İslahiye tent city but population figure is for all.

[‡] 15 March is the date of first movement took place from Hatay.

1. Highlights:

- ❖ 182 persons who entered Turkey through Reyhanlı on April 7, 2012 returned to their homeland instead of being transferred to Ceylanpınar camp in Şanlıurfa which is 550 km. away from Reyhanlı.
- ❖ It has been reported that, 62 persons who entered through Reyhanlı and 107 persons who entered through Kilis borders were settled in Ceylanpınar camp in Şanlıurfa.
- ❖ It has been reported that Kızılay established a regional coordination center in Gaziantep for the assistance.
