

## Highlights



- There is no updated figures announced by the Government of Turkey since August 19, 2012. Local Officials informed UNHCR that during the 24 hours of August, 20-21, 2012 approximately 3,000 persons of new arrivals were admitted to Turkey from both Hatay (2,000) and Kilis (1,000) borders, and approximately 1,000 are waiting at the borders in the process of admission.
- Reportedly with the recent new arrivals, the unofficial estimated total number of Syrians registered and placed in camps and schools reached to 75,000 persons which is about 70% increase since end of July during three weeks in August 2012.
- The local officials informed UNHCR that due to the shortage of capacity in the camps, some of the new arrivals are sent to Malatya to be placed in schools temporarily while some are still kept in the reception center in Reyhanli until the temporary accommodation is arranged.
- The local officials also informed that delivery of humanitarian aid to the vulnerable people in Syria is continuing at the zero point at the border.
