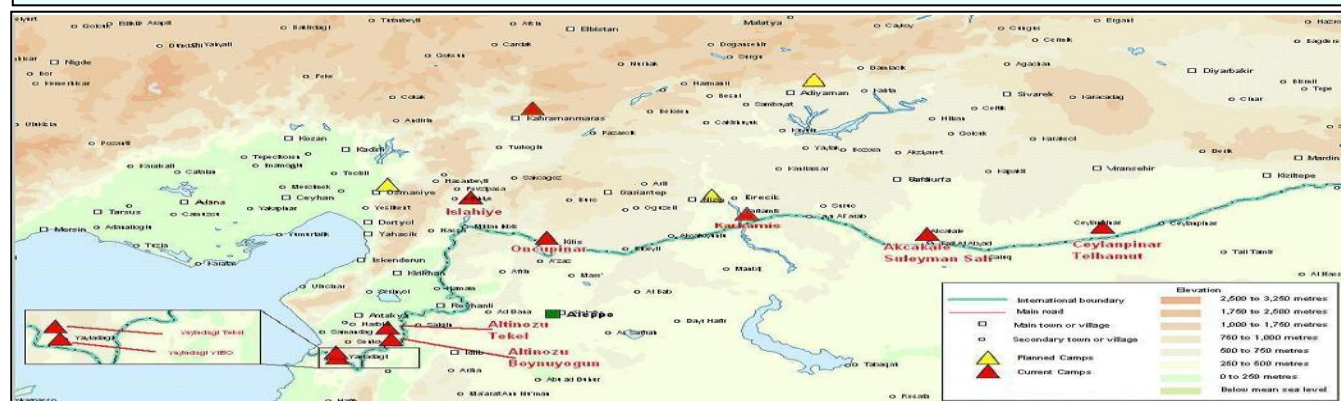

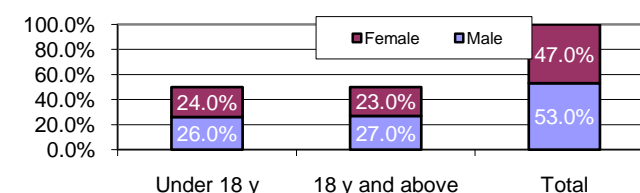

### Highlights

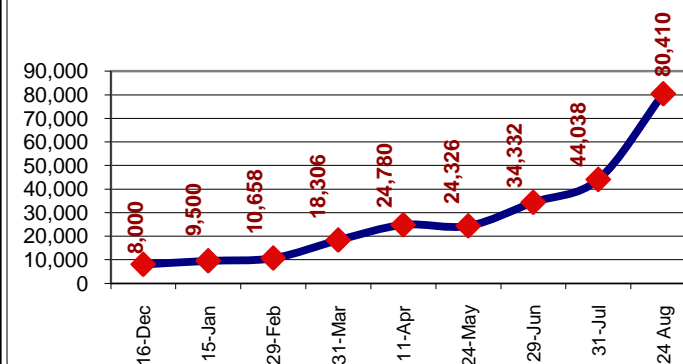
- There is no new number reported by the Government of Turkey on August 31, 2012. Official numbers remained the same; 80,410.
- Local authorities informed UNHCR that during the 24 hrs of August 30-31, 2012, 112 new arrivals were admitted and 62 Syrians returned to Syria voluntarily.
- Local authorities informed that with a very slight increase, the total number of Syrians registered and accommodated in camps and temporarily in schools as well as those in the hospitals under medical treatment is 80,453 of which some 24% are still in the schools. Local authorities (MFA) stated that the priority is given for the relocation of those in the schools to the camps which are being opened gradually.
- According to the authorities, there are still more than 8,000 people waiting across the border on the Syrian side. Reportedly the border is not closed and humanitarian assistance (food-water-medical assistance) is provided to them at the zero point of the border.
