


Highlights

- On September 10, 2012, the Government of Turkey officially announced that the number of Syrians registered and accommodated in the camps including those under medical treatment in the hospitals is 80,104 persons.
- It was announced by AFAD that as of September 10, 2012, all the Syrians who have been temporarily accommodated in the schools have been transferred to camps. Reportedly the camps in Kahramanmaraş and Osmaniye are also operational now which brings the number of operational camps to 12 including the container site in Kilis.
- According to information from AFAD, four more camps are under construction and are expected to be operational by end of September 2012. The new camps are being built in Adiyaman, two in Gaziantep-Nizip and an additional one in Şanlıurfa-Akçakale.
- Reportedly during the 24 hrs of September 9-10, 868 persons were admitted and placed in the camps and 103 Syrians have returned to Syria voluntarily.
- Reportedly there is no restriction in admission of those seeking temporary protection however the process is slow due to procedures and security checks and people are admitted in smaller groups.
