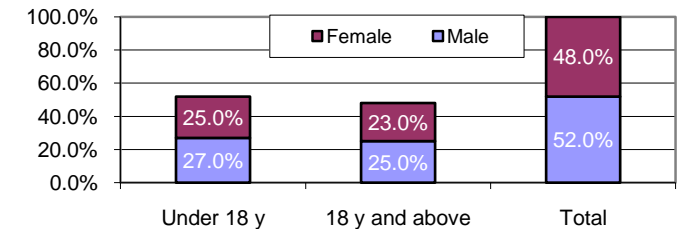

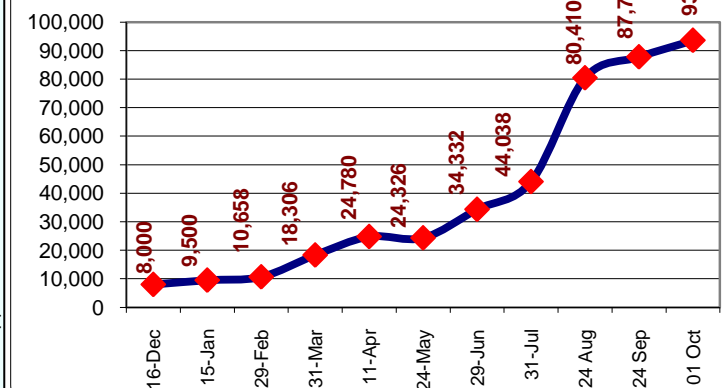
Highlights

- There is no new official figures reported by the Government of Turkey since October 1, 2012. However according to the information from the Representative of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Kilis, with the latest new arrivals, the total number of Syrians accommodated in 14 camps operational in seven provinces and those under medical treatment in the hospitals is 95,774 as of September 4, 2012 which is about 5% increase since the end of September 2012.
- Reportedly during the 24 hrs of 3-4 October 2012, 806 new arrival Syrians were admitted and accommodated in the camps while 103 Syrians have returned to Syria during the same period.
- The situation in Akçakale continued to be widely covered by by national media. Government of Turkey is authorized by the Parliament for cross border operations if needed. UN Security Council and NATO condemned Syria for the attack to Turkey.
- According to the information from local authorities in Akçakale there is no big movement of Syrians towards Turkey but reportedly 88 new arrival Syrians were admitted and registered in the camp in Akçakale on October 4, 2012 which brought the camp population to more than 12,000.
