




Population Trends




Number of Syrians by Province

Highlights

- On 14 Jan 2013, although it has not yet been fully completed, it was reported by AFAD that about 1,100 Syrians who were temporarily accommodated in public facilities/guesthouses in Nizip town have been transferred to the container site in Harran Kokenli in Sanliurfa province. This brought the total number of operational camps to 15 including 2 container sites (Kilis-Oncupinar and Sanliurfa-Harran Kokenli). Reportedly the opening of Nizip-2 container site will be delayed for a few weeks as the work has not been completed to accommodate people.
- During the visit to the Nizip camp UNHCR staff was informed by the local authorities that approximately 2,800 Syrians have been accommodated in public facilities/guest houses in Nizip however as in consultation with the central government authorities/AFAD Directorate some 700 Syrians were transferred to Van and accommodated in containers which were used by earthquake survivors. Reportedly some few hundreds were transferred to Adana and Adiyaman while the rest were transferred to Gaziantep and temporarily accommodated in sports centers.
- According to information from AFAD, during the 24 hrs of 13-14 Jan 2013, some 1,285 Syrian new comers were registered in the camps while 137 Syrians have returned to Syria voluntarily.
- With these new arrivals and the opening of Harran container site, the total number of Syrians who have been registered in 15 camps in 7 provinces increased to 154,705 including 144 who are under medical treatment in hospitals.
- UNHCR Field Teams continue to visit the camps and work in cooperation with the local authorities while also observing the voluntary nature of the returns from the camps as per Directive on Reception and Accommodation of Syrians under temporary protection in Turkey.
- According to the information from national media which is also confirmed by the the local authorities, that a Syrian shell struck an olive grove in Turkey side of the border near Kilis Oncupinar container site. No casualties were reported.
