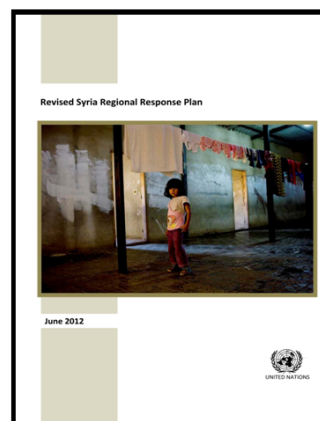


Revised Syria Regional Response Plan

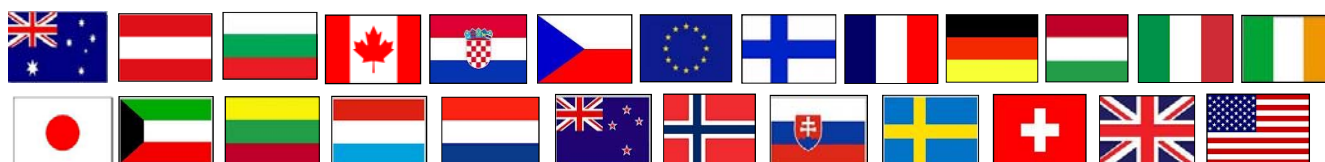
