




## Highlights

- On 21 April 2013, AFAD - Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey announced that the total number of Syrians registered and accommodated in 17 camps in 8 provinces is 191,751 including 302 Syrians under medical treatment in the hospitals. Since beginning of Jan 2013, the total number of Syrians registered and accommodated in the camps increased 43,310 persons (29%). On 21 April 2013, AFAD reported that 233 Syrians were admitted to Turkey for camp placement. AFAD reported that the total number of Syrians voluntarily returned to Syria exceeds 24,000 since the beginning of 2013.
- In January 2013, AFAD published a circular that medical assistance will be provided to all non-camp Syrians in 11 provinces and when they approach the health institutions they will also be registered by AFAD Office if they have not already been registered. In line with a recent circular issued by the Ministry of Health, the free medical assistance to non-camp Syrians will be provided only to those who are living in the provinces where there are camps for Syrians. The medical bills of the Syrians who are residing in provinces where there are no camps (currently only 8 provinces have camps), will not be covered by AFAD.
- According to the information provided by various local officials (AFAD Coordination Centers, local police and sub governorates) the total number of non-camp Syrians registered with the authorities increased to almost 88,000 persons while some more than 33,000 Syrians were given appointments by AFAD Coordination Center in Gaziantep.
- Apart from providing NFI's (additional tents, and kitchen sets and cooking sets with fridges) UNHCR Field Teams continue to be present in all the camps regularly and while observing regularly a percentage of the voluntary return interviews conducted by the camp officials, UNHCR staff also provide support and expertise to the camp authorities on protection and community services related challenges. UNHCR Teams are welcomed by the camp officials to participate in their meetings with the refugee representatives in the camps.
- On 19 April 2013, in Adana Saricam camp, it was reported that a child of 1.5 years old was accidentally hit by the food delivery vehicle of the catering company and unfortunately died. Reportedly the driver was detained immediately and despite the initial tension from the camp residents, the situation is now described as calm.
