






Age & Gender of Registered Syrian Refugees



## Highlights

- On 23 April 2013, AFAD - Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey announced that the total number of Syrians registered and accommodated in 17 camps in 8 provinces is 192,199 including 302 Syrians under medical treatment in the hospitals.
- AFAD, the Emergency and Disaster Management Agency of Government of Turkey reported that during the last 24hrs of 22-23 April 2013, 304 Syrians were admitted from the borders and accommodated in the camps while 226 Syrians voluntarily returned to Syria. This brought the total number of Syrians arrived in Turkey since Jan 2013 to 54,643 persons and total number of voluntarily returned to Syrians to more than 25,000 during the same period.
- MFA regional representative informed UNHCR that there are 7 IDP camps across the border of Hatay/Reyhanli hosting approximately 47,000 persons and the camp in Bab-Al Salama across Kilis/Oncupinar border crossing is hosting about 11,000 Syrians. According to various sources, the sanitation conditions in Bab Al Salama is very dire and Turkish Government will be providing support including tents to make the conditions better.
- UNHCR Field Team was informed by the camp officials in Ceylanpiar that 3,500 kitchen sets donated by UNHCR have been received and some of them were transferred to Harran camp and another private company provided school bags to the children in Islahiye. In Nizip camps the toys which were collected in France and donated to Kizilay through UNHCR will be distributed to the children.
- It was informed by the camp officials that the digital finger printing of the Syrians in the camps is about to be completed soon. Reportedly the registration system in all the camps will be switched to central data base program which will allow all the camps to cross-check the bio-data of a new comer.
- The local authorities informed UNHCR Field Teams that the self initiative schools have been established in various provinces (Kilis and Hatay Reyhanli) and also the one in Gaziantep established by Gaziantep Metropolitan Municipality is very much appreciated by the Syrians living in urban. Reportedly the Syrian Curriculum is implemented.
