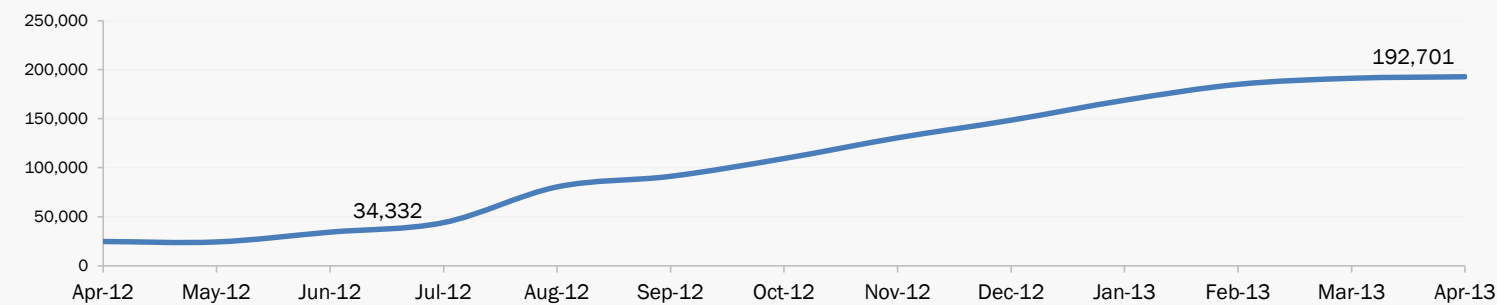
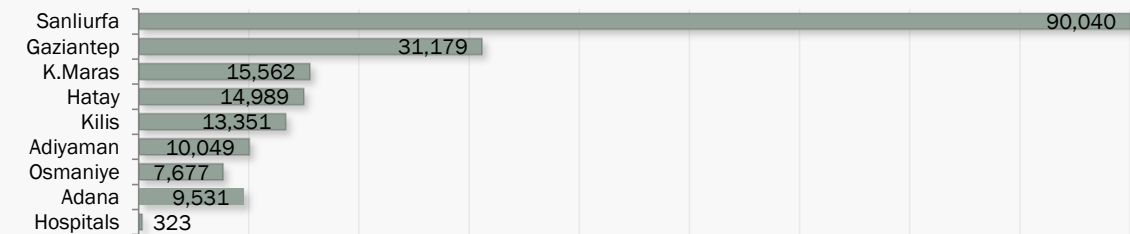


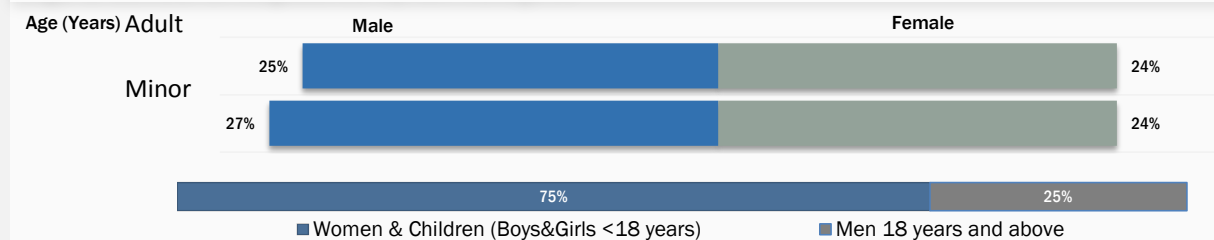

Highlights

- On 28 April 2013, AFAD - Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey announced that the total number of Syrians registered and accommodated in 17 camps in 8 provinces is 192,701 including 323 Syrians under medical treatment in the hospitals. This is about 30% increase since beginning of Jan 2013.
- UNHCR Field Teams, on average, have noted a reduced number of volreps during the last few weeks. While UNHCR Field Teams will continue to assess the situation it may be due to reports of increased fighting in Northern and other parts of Syria.
- The number of non camp Syrians registered and given appointments to be registered by the local authorities was 123,494 persons as of 26 April 2013. The Coordination Center in Sanliurfa province is established and will also start to register the non camp Syrians in Sanliurfa province which is estimated to be some 40,000. It was also reported that the similar practice is expected to be implemented in Hatay province. According to the local officials only in Reyhanli there are approximately 35,000 Syrians living in urban while some NGOs estimate this number to be much higher.
- UNHCR Field Teams was informed by the camp officials that the Youth Committee in Harran camp has a positive impact. The Youth Committee members visited the Akcakale camp and will also visit Ceylanpinar camp, meet with the officials to share their experiences in practice and the refugee representatives in other camps. UNHCR Field Teams support and advocate the initiative as an example of good practice for refugee participation to the management in the camps.
- While the preparations of supermarkets are on going in several camps which are planned to be switched to food card system, UNHCR Field teams are informed that the UNHCR kitchen sets including the hot plates have been received by the camp managements and will soon be distributed. In Ceylanpinar camp the authorities also informed that they received the new tents which they will also replenish the existing tents before summer. Reportedly due to the weather conditions in Ceylanpinar the tents usage life is shorter than expected.
