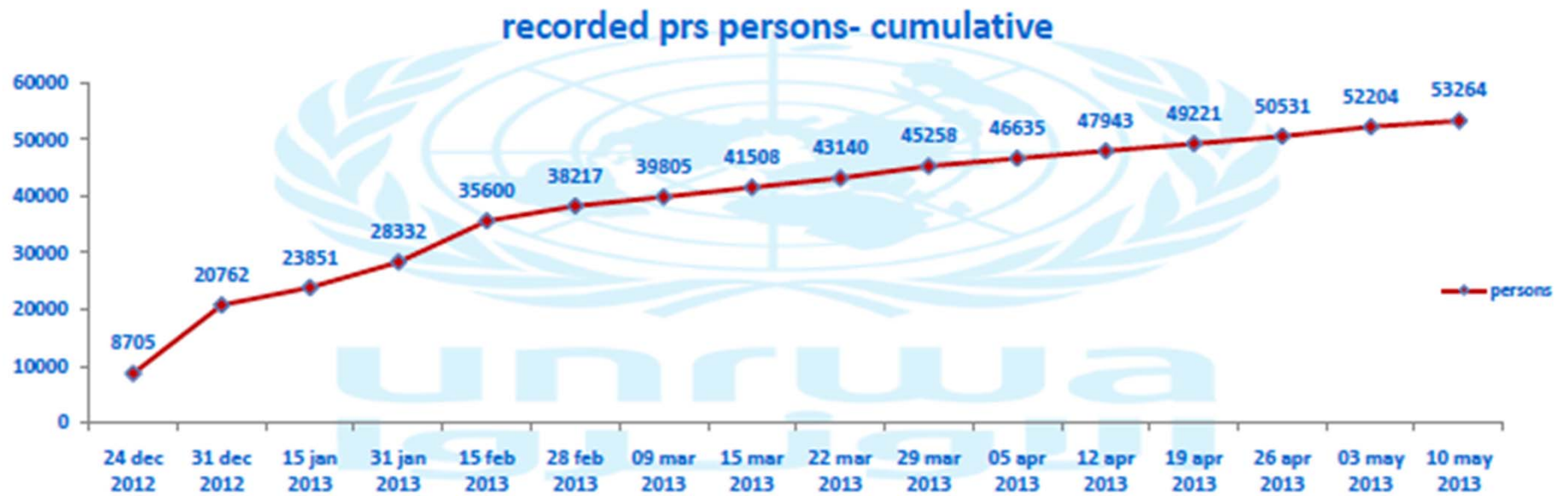
## Number of PRS in Lebanon

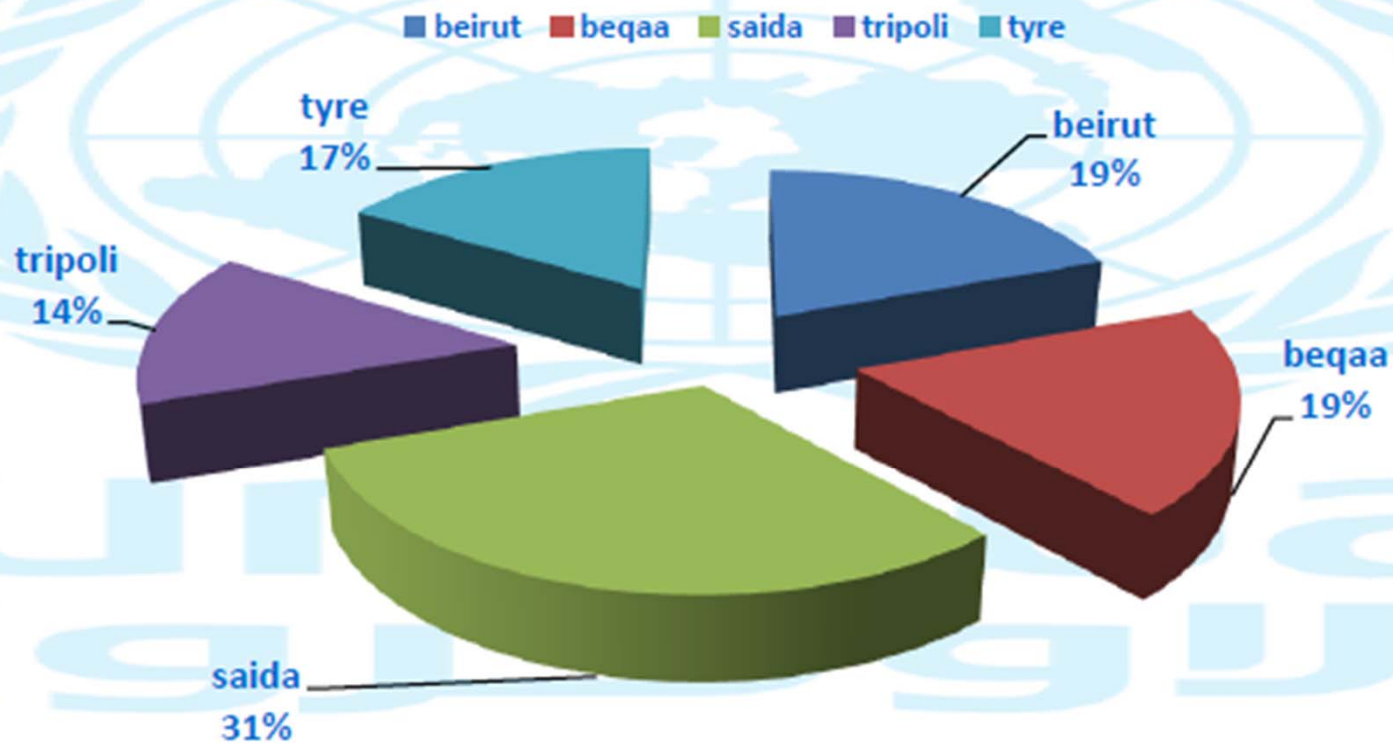

# DEMOGRAPHIC DATA (10<sup>th</sup> May 2013)



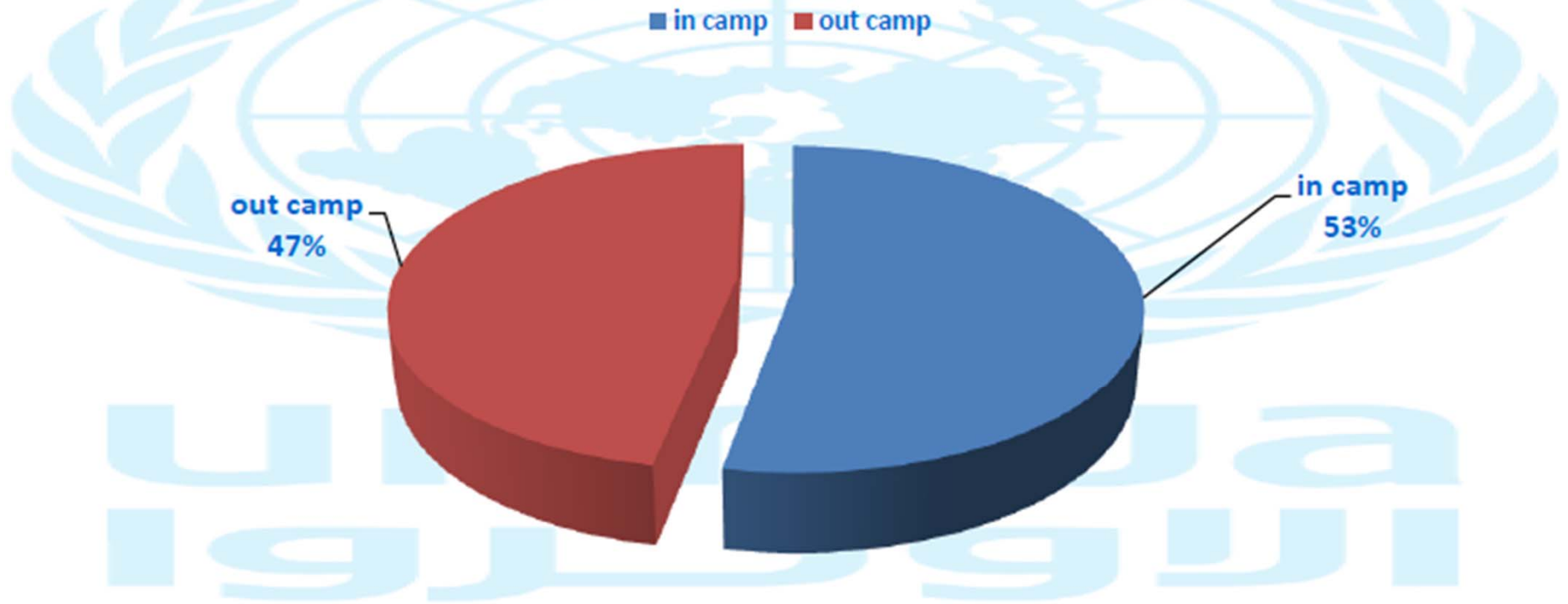
# DEMOGRAPHIC DATA (10<sup>th</sup> May 2013)

## recorded prs families per area



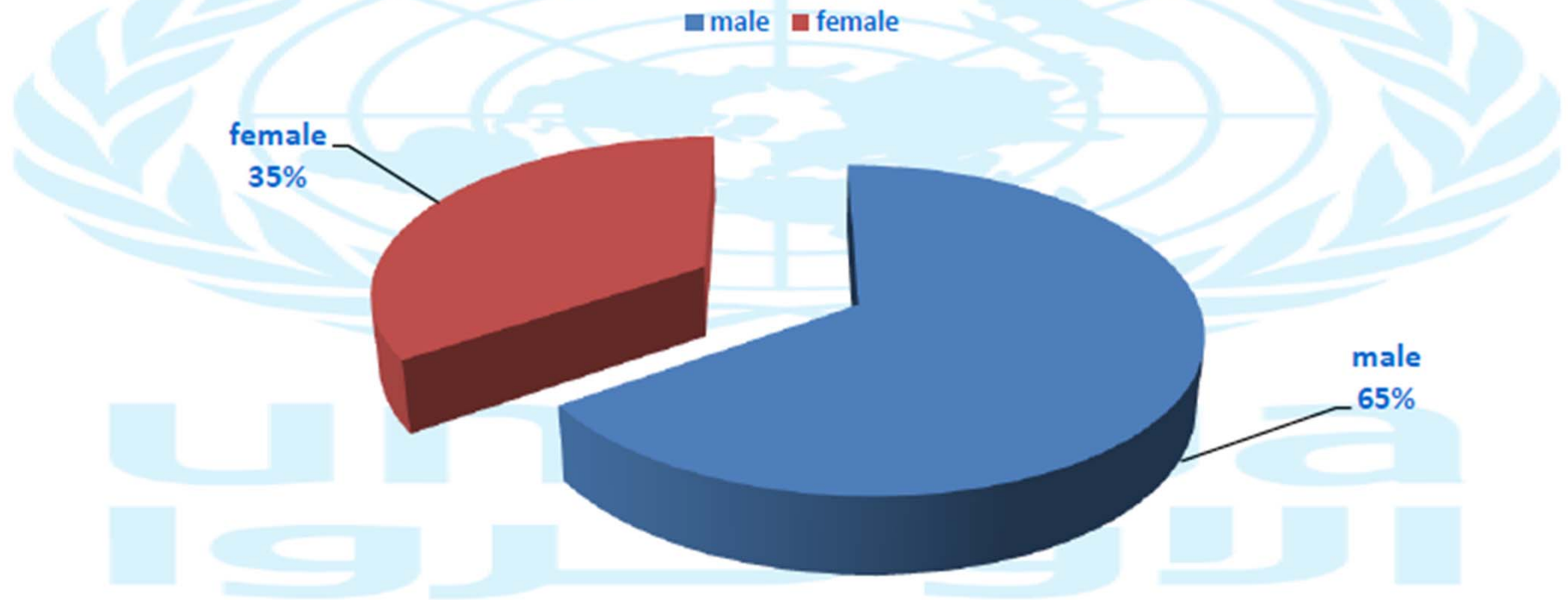

# Health, Education, NFI, Protection Update

## Education

- From 25 April to 2 May 2013, UNRWA distributed 50,000 LL clothing-vouchers for PRS children enrolled in UNRWA schools (donated by UNICEF)
- 3,671 children are attending UNRWA schools



## Health

- CARE Programme: UNRWA started to support a limited number of PRS patients suffering from catastrophic health conditions . Additional support will be provided to cover bills including hospitalization (\$8,000 and up) for illness such as cancer, MS etc.
- Lice and Scabies UNRWA has distributed additional anti-lice shampoo in schools for all children and in the clinics. UNRWA is also working with UNICEF on securing additional stocks for treatment of scabies.

## Health (2)

- 34,132 individuals PRS have files in UNRWA health clinics
- 1,303 patients have received hospitalizations for urgent and life saving conditions
- 287 patients that benefited from out patient tests
- 4 cancer patients benefited from supports in the cost of cancer medications

# Shelter Rehabilitation

- 8 requests for rehabilitation of shelter have been completed (6 in Saida and 2 in Tyre)
- 6 additional shelter requests have been approved but not yet completed which will provide housing for 60 more families. (3 in Saida, 3 in Tyre)

# Upcoming Cash Distribution

- Next cash distribution will take place in Mid June
- Nationwide coverage
- Amount TBC

# Protection

- Partners continue to enter into data sharing protocol in order to facilitate access to the UNRWA lists
- Protection unit to launch a GBV/Child Protection Mapping in the camps, in line with the relevant working groups
- Protection unit is continuously monitoring the border and the visa regime : to date there have been no issues, the border remains open and there are no reports of visa's not being renewed

# NFI Update

- Active coordination with DRC and partners
- Procurement based on UNHCR standards
- UNRWA Database updated to include data on NFI's received todate
