





## Age & Gender of Registered Syrian Refugees



## Highlights

- On 19 August 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 20 camps in 10 provinces was 201,025, including 518 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the last 24 hours, 803 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps while 788 Syrians voluntarily returned to Syria.
- Local officials in Kilis informed UNHCR Team that some 3,000 - 4,000 non-camp Syrians, including those in Musalla Park, have been transferred to the container site in Elbeyli. The authorities reported that they will take necessary precautions to avoid the pull-factor.
- The fight between the opposition groups in Rasul Ayn across the border of Ceylanpinar is still on-going. UNHCR Field Teams are informed by various camp officials that there are spontaneous arrivals approaching the camps and requesting admittance. Those who have immediate family members are admitted. In Akcakale camp, the officials informed UNHCR that because of the shortage of space, they are referring people to Ceylanpinar. Reportedly, on 13 August, about 350 spontaneous arrivals approaching Akcakale camp were diverted to Ceylanpinar camp. Reportedly from Akcakale border gate, passport-holders continue to be admitted.
- In Harran container site, camp officials informed UNHCR Field Teams that they are establishing a new data base for their warehouse to track their stocks as well as the distribution of the items to camp residents. Reportedly with this data base system, the camp management will also monitor medicine distribution to avoid the abuse of medical consumption.
- Adiyaman Camp officials informed UNHCR Field Team that during Eid Al Fitr they had received about 600 Syrians visiting their relatives in the camp. However, the situation of the visitors is becoming very challenging for the camp management, because some of them are reluctant to leave. Reportedly, in addition to the visitors, AFAD referred some 82 new arrivals from Ceylanpinar to Adiyaman camp. Because of the shortage of space in the camp, the new arrivals were offered to be accommodated in the communal tent. However, some 18 of them refused and wanted to return to Ceylanpinar. They were provided transportation back to Ceylanpinar.
