

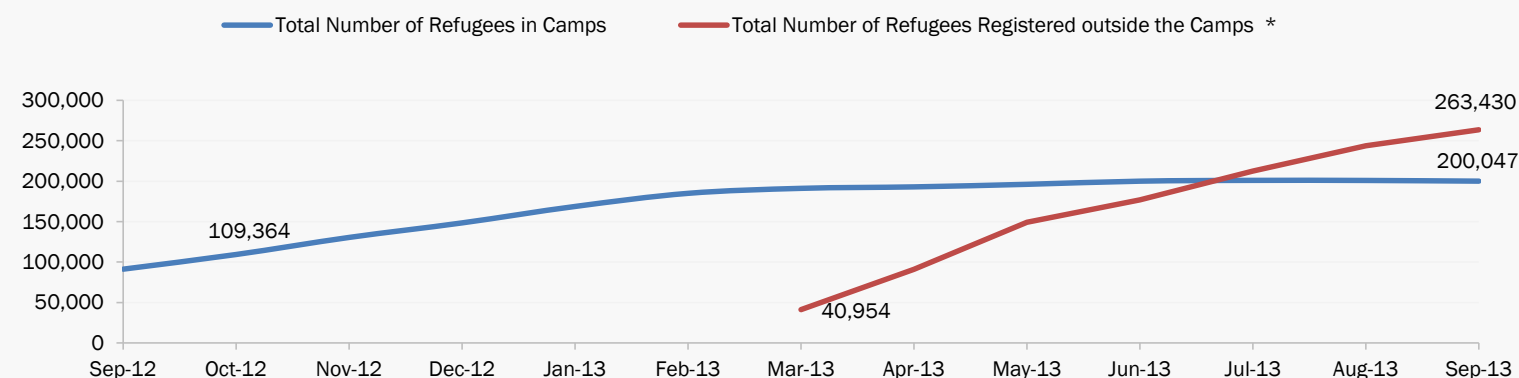

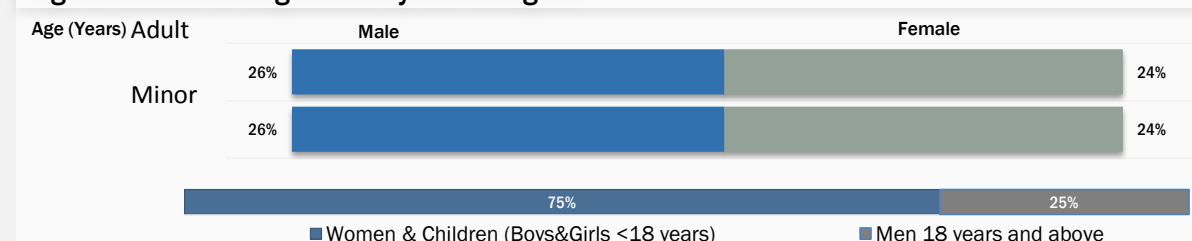

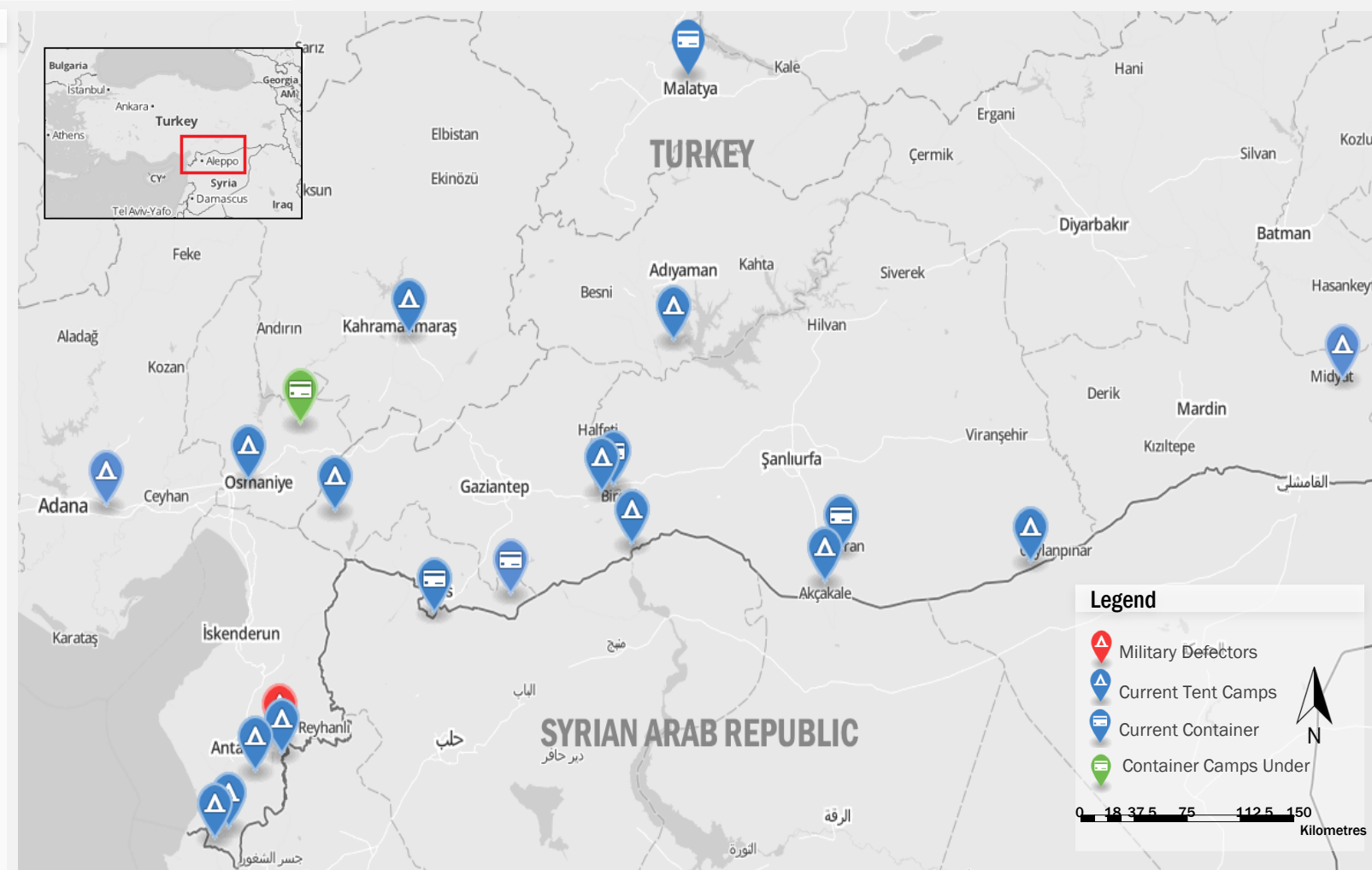

## Highlights

- On 30 September 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 21 camps in 10 provinces was 200,047, including 614 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the 24hrs of 29-30 Sept. 2013, a total of 216 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 225 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- On Monday 30 Sept. 2013, during the visit to Nizip, UNHCR Field Team observed that there are no Syrians staying in the parks and the main mosque where several hundreds of Syrians were staying during last week. Reportedly some 200 of them were transferred to Nizip-1 camp (tent site) and have been temporarily accommodated in the rub hall size tents until they are transferred to camps where the space is available. The camp officials also informed that in case of voluntary returns the emptied tents would be provided to those who are accommodated in the waiting tents.
- The population of Mardin Midyat camp has increased to almost 3,000 during the weekend. The camp officials informed the UNHCR Field Team that more than 500 Syrians (about 90 - 100 families) have been transferred from Nizip town to Midyat camp during the weekend. Camp officials informed UNHCR Field Team that they are planning to put additional tents to accommodate the new-arrivals transferred from Nizip.
- In Mardin the UNHCR Field Team was informed by local officials that, with the support of the sub-governorate a Turkish NGO/Charity Association, a school in Kiziltepe town has been set up to provide education to the children of non-camp Syrians in Kiziltepe. Reportedly the Turkish NGO had enumerated more than 2,000 school-age children of the non-camp Syrians living in Kiziltepe town. The school has already registered 52 children in the school and will continue to register children for level 1-5. The school building has 6 classrooms, and with the foreseen donation of 15 containers by another Turkish NGO the school's capacity will be expanded. The same NGO is planning to open additional schools in Nusaybin and Senyurt towns which were already approved by the sub-governors and in Viransehir town if the sub-governor agrees.
- The NGO/Charity Association in Kiziltepe informed UNHCR that they have enumerated some 4,138 families living in Kiziltepe since March 2013 and have provided food packages. Reportedly they have also registered the families for future assistance.
