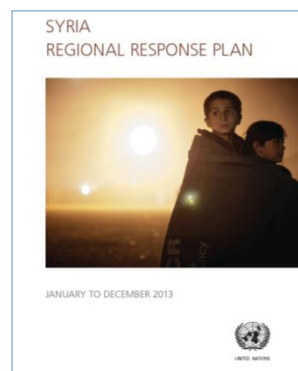
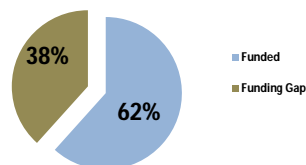


**Revised SYRIA REGIONAL RESPONSE PLAN - RRP (all agencies)**
