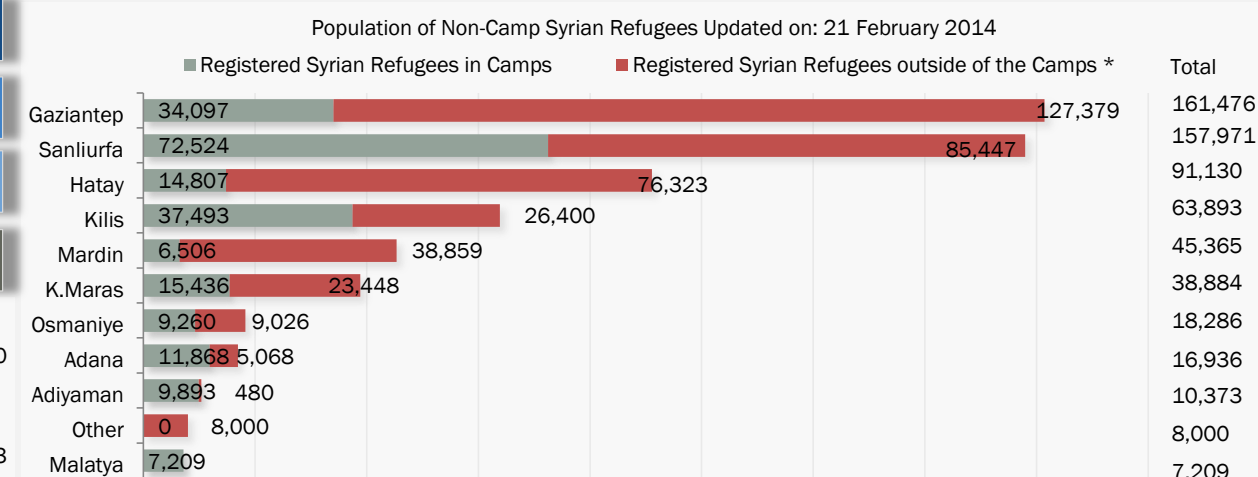
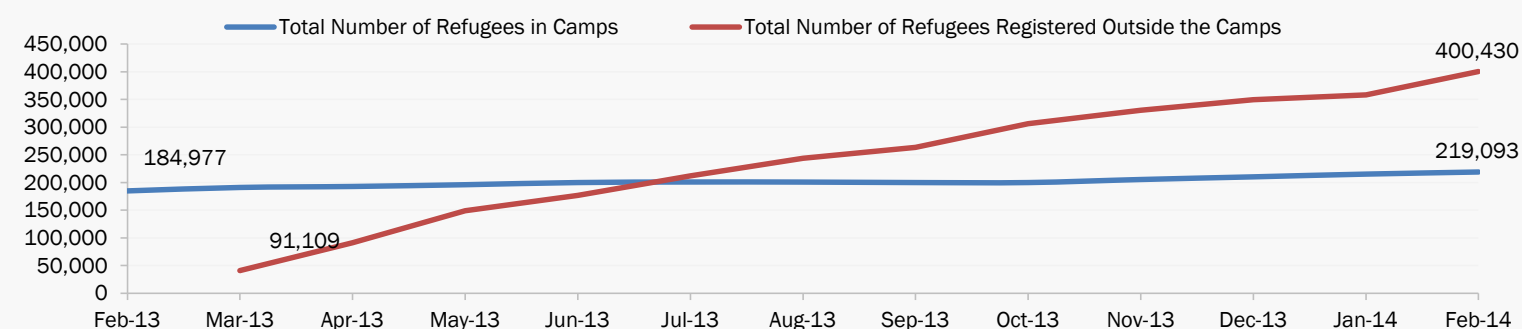


Total Number of Refugees Registered and with Registration Appointments	619,523

Highlights

- On 25 February 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 219,093. AFAD reported that during the period of 24-25 Feb 2014, a total of 154 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 273 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- Almost 115,000 of the total of 150,000 sets of clothing UNHCR procured for all children aged 02-17 years in all the camps have been delivered to camps and distribution is on-going. As part of support for winterization a total of 240,000 high-thermal blankets have been procured and delivered to the TRC warehouse and over 15,000 of them have so far been distributed to the refugees. Upon request of the Akcakale camp management, UNHCR also provided medical items including an ultrasound machine, stretchers etc. to the Rehabilitation Center which is run by the refugees and which provides support to refugees who were discharged from hospitals.
- In Akcakale camp the management informed that they also received the donation of second-hand clothes from Kocaeli-Cayirova Municipality in cooperation with the Provincial Religious Affairs. Distribution of these clothes is organized together with the Youth Committee and Women Committee of the camp under the supervision of the camp management. The families are given the possibility to choose 3 pieces per person.
- In Ceylanpinar, the management informed that they have received two trucks of food and non-food items as a private donation from Balikesir and Eskisehir cities. The food items were handed over to Kizilay to be distributed to the non-camp Syrians living in Ceylanpinar town. Reportedly some more than 1,000 families were provided food packages. In another donation through one of the residents of Ceylanpinar camp, the management received 1,300 USD to buy flour to be distributed to all the camp residents.
- In Adiyaman camp, officials informed UNHCR that in addition to UNHCR donated clothes they have also received some additional clothes from a private company as well as second hand clothing from a Turkish NGO as a donation and will keep them in their warehouse to be distributed in the future.
