




Age & Gender of Registered Syrian Refugees



Highlights

- On 13 March 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 220,177. AFAD reported that during the period of 12-13 March 2014, a total of 433 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 339 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- Adiyaman camp officials informed UNHCR that after they had transferred all the refugees accommodated in the waiting area to Nusaybin camp in consultation with AFAD Ankara, during the following week 13 new arrivals approached the camp. In addition to these new arrivals, camp management informed that there are 55 people who are still in the camp staying with their relatives as guests.
- In Akcakale town center, the sub-governorate and TRC (Turkish Red Crescent) opened a warehouse/shop to distribute NFIs. The authorities have received 14,000 pieces of clothing from a private company, and beneficiaries chose 2-3 pieces of clothes in their size in the warehouse. Reportedly 40 families are provided clothing on a daily basis.
- In Kahramanmaraş, camp officials informed UNHCR that they will be putting up 20 more tents to accommodate spontaneous arrivals of relatives of the camp residents. Kahramanmaraş camp officials also informed that the Governorate is preparing 6 class rooms, which will be used as a school for the education of non-camp Syrians' children living the city center.
- The registration of non-camp Syrians in Kilis is on-going and as of 13 March, the police registered 27,650 non-camp Syrians. As of 13 March 2014, 2 mobile registration units that were sent to Kilis also became operational and the police will continue the registration in the mobile registration units. With these two in Kilis, 7 of the 12 Mobile Registration Units which were sent to 8 provinces are operational as of 13 March 2013. Local officials in Nizip informed that the center in Nizip will also be operational in the coming days.
