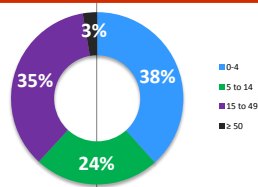

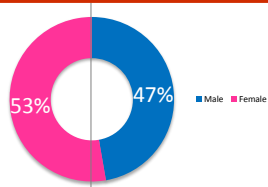

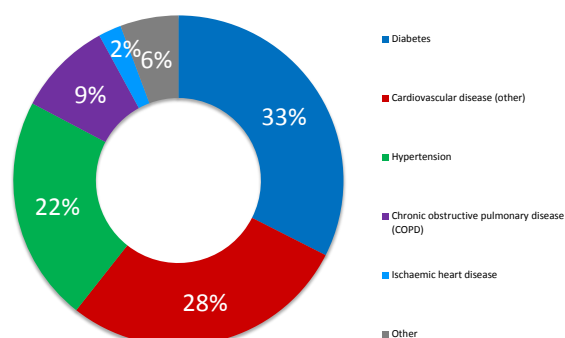

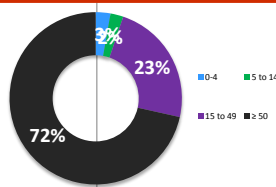

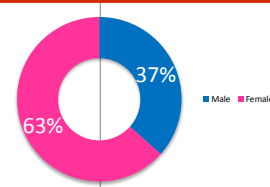

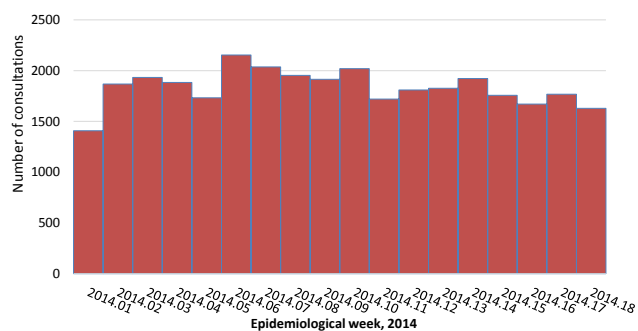

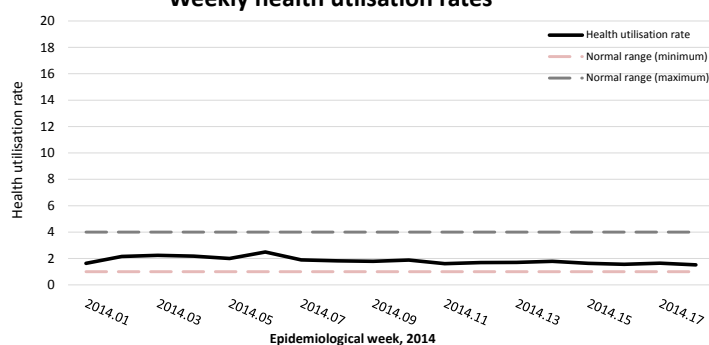

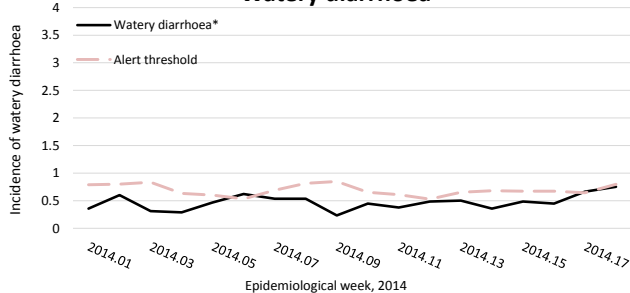
### Number of consultations



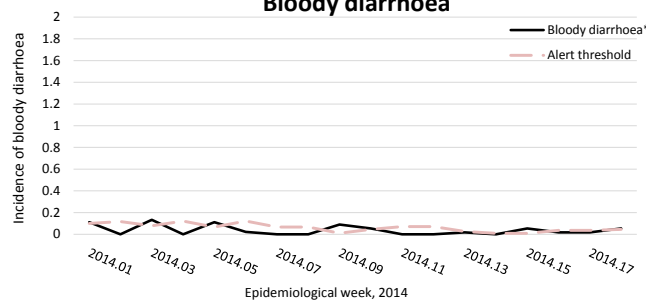
### Weekly health utilisation rates



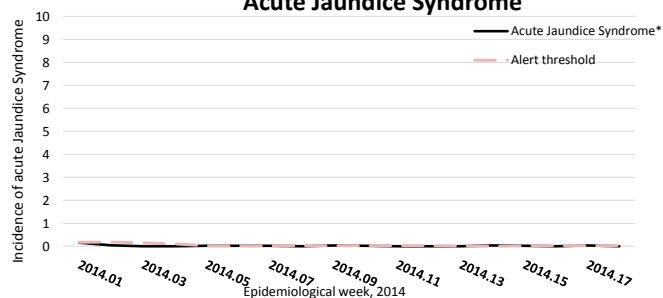
### Watery diarrhoea



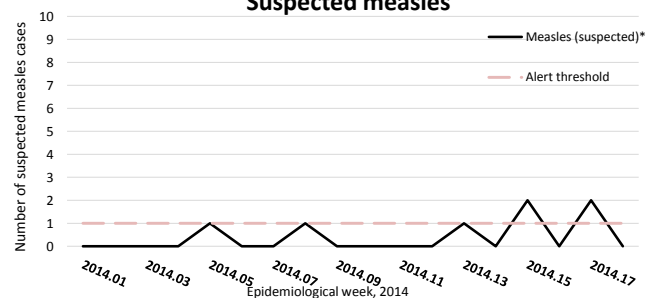
### Bloody diarrhoea



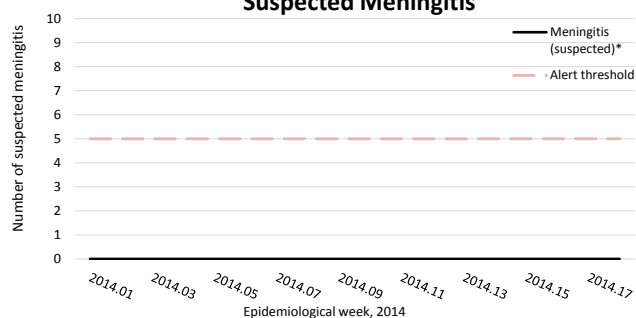

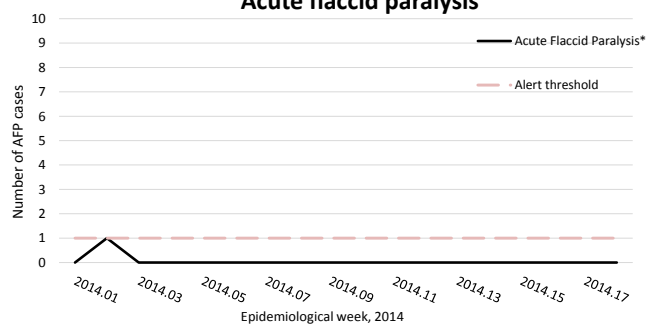

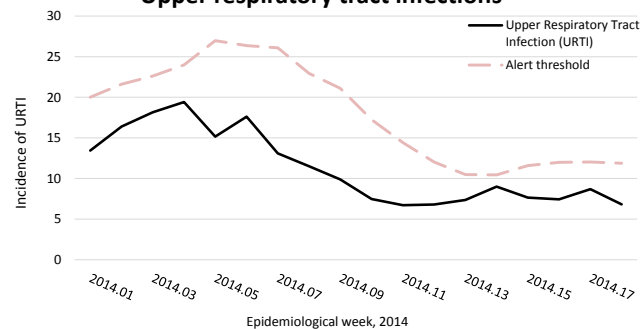

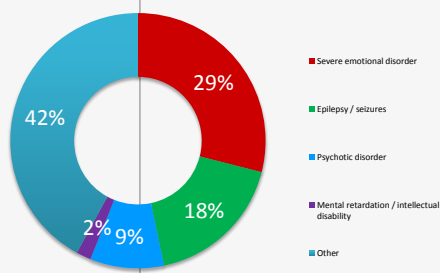

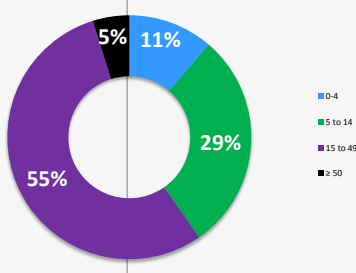

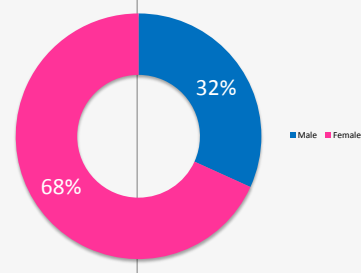
### By cause



### By age

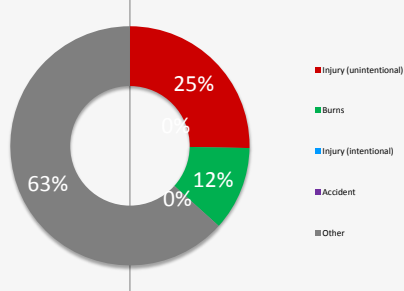

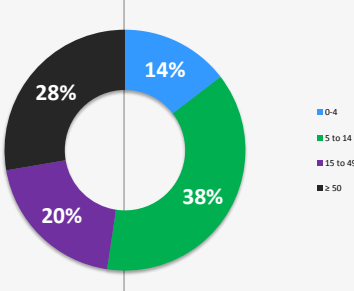

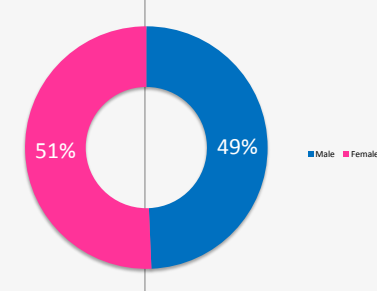
