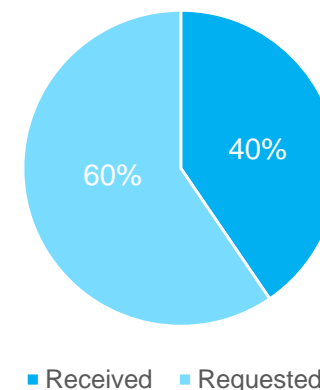

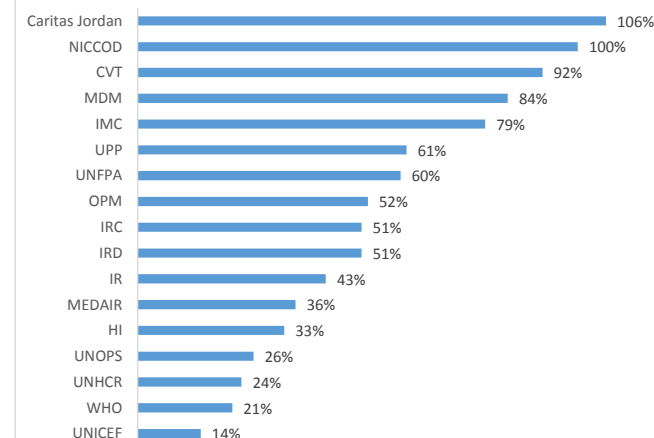
Agencies reported
